



EVENT RULES

Failure to follow these rules may result in fines or other penalties at the discretion of the event organizer.

1. Wristbands must always be worn and visible.
2. No participant may access other areas of the facility unless prior authorization has been given.
3. 5 mph speed limit in the paddock must be obeyed at all times.
4. 15 mph speed limit on all access roads must be obeyed at all times.
5. Stop signs and other traffic signals must be obeyed at all times.
6. The use of blocks or pads is **MANDATORY**. They must be placed under all under jacks, trailers, etc. Spring Mountain Paddock Marshal will supply blocks if needed and provide instructions for return at the conclusion of the event.
7. Stakes may not be driven into any asphalt within the facility including but not limited to track areas or paddock areas.
8. Jack stands with pads must be used whenever any person is under any part of a lifted vehicle.
9. Any vehicles leaking oil, coolant, fuel, or other fluids must have a pan placed underneath to catch the leak.
10. All participants must park properly and adhere to assigned spaces (if applicable).
11. For the safety of all participants, walking, riding, or driving beyond cones or barriers surrounding the track is strictly prohibited.
12. Walking, riding, or driving on the track outside of the event times is strictly prohibited (i.e., Bikes, rollerblades, scooters, skateboards, skates, etc.).
13. Testing, cool downs or brake bedding is prohibited on the access roads or in the paddock. **All cool downs must be done on track at the end of each session.**
14. No oil, fuel, or other hazardous liquid may be filled without properly protecting the paddock surface. If a designated fueling area is assigned, no fueling may take place outside of that area.
15. Any spills must be cleaned with oil dry **IMMEDIATELY**. Paddock Marshal will supply oil dry if needed.
16. **No vehicle parts may be disposed of in the trashcans provided on the paddock. These items MUST BE PLACED IN A SEPARATE DUMPSTER** which will be provided by Spring Mountain and clearly marked.
17. It is the sole responsibility of participants to dispose of hazardous waste in any way that is environmentally conscious and respectful.
18. Any used/empty containers (fuel, oil, other fluids etc.) must be picked up and properly disposed of off Spring Mountain property. If any such waste is left behind, a \$300 cleaning fee will be charged.
19. All teams are working hard, please respect the space of all participants.
20. All dogs must remain on leash (per Nevada law). Owners must clean up after their dogs.
21. Fire pits and BBQs are permitted if they are properly contained and ashes disposed of properly in marked receptacles.
22. Lighting off any fireworks is strictly prohibited.
23. The use of illegal substances is strictly prohibited.
24. All alcohol consumption is strictly prohibited when the track is hot.
25. The use of drones is prohibited unless prior authorization has been given.
