SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

2022 MiDiv TT rules

REGISTRATION: Drivers can register for the race online at www.motorsportsreg.com. A full refund will be made if the entry is withdrawn prior to receiving a Tech sticker. If you pre-register and are a no show, you will forfeit any payments made, even if deferred. If you sign in at registration and do not go thru, or pass, Tech, you must notify the Chief of Registration, *BEFORE YOU LEAVE THE TRACK*, in order to receive your refund. Withdrawn entries made via Phone/fax will not be accepted.

At-event Registration will be held in the credentials building located just to left before entering the paddock.

ENTRY FEES: Entry fees for TT-

Team or Individual Sat and Sun: \$325

ENTRY FEE PAYMENT: The entrant using online registration via <u>www.motorsportsreg.com</u> will only have the option of paying by credit card at the time of registration. Credit card payments will be deferred until at least Monday, May 23rd, 2022. If you wish to make other payment arrangements, you must contact the registrar prior to finalizing your registration.

TT DRIVER ELIGIBILITY: See 2022 MiDiv TT rules section 3

TT CAR ELIGIBILITY: See 2022 MiDiv TT rules section 5,6 and 7

This event will also allow 2022 SCCA National TT classes. The safety rules outlined in the 2022 MiDiv TT rules will supersede any safety rules in the National ruleset. The following is a link to the 2022 SCCA National TT classes:

TT COMPETITION NUMBERS: See 2022 MiDiv TT rules section 8

TECH: All drivers must present to Tech their driver gear and vehicle for inspection. All drivers/entrants shall provide a completed event tech card for review. After inspection a tech sticker will be issued. The inspection area will be located inside the paddock along the false grid.

SCALES: Will be available at Tech during Tech hours. Scales may be made available at other times at the discretion of the Chief of Tech.

DRIVERS MEETING: A drivers meeting will be held for TT drivers, attendance is mandatory unless prior arrangements have been made with the Competition Director or a Driver coach.





EVENT SCHEDULE/RUN GROUPS: The event schedule or run groups may be changed at the discretion of the Competition Director and event host, with concurrence by the Event Lead, depending on pre-race entry counts or as needed to accommodate situations that may be encountered during the event. If changes are made prior to the start of the event, as much notice as possible will be given to all affected competitors. The schedule as published is for planning purposes only. Actual session start times may deviate from the published schedule based on actual event progression. Listen to the PA system and pay attention to what is happening on track.

TT IMPOUND: After the 2nd Points session, the all finishers in each class shall report to Tech immediately following completion of their cool-off lap for weighing. You may return to your pit after your weight is verified.

GRID: Starting positions for the Saturday points sessions shall be determined by the fastest time recorded for each car during the preceding practice session. Cars arriving to the grid after their group has been released on track may, at the discretion of the Grid Marshall, be held at pit out to then be released to the back of the field after the field has completed the pace lap. Shirts are required and shoes that cover the entire foot are also required in hot area

PIT: Do not stand or sit on the Pit Wall or climb on fences. Shirts, shoes that cover the entire foot and long pants are also required in the hot pit area. Crew members on pit lane must display their event credentials at all times while on pit lane. Smoking is prohibited in the hot or cold pit lane. PIT LANE SPEED is 25 MPH. No refueling in pit lane

START/FINISH: The race will begin and end at the stripe in front of timing and scoring.

TRACK / **SAFETY:** Black flag station will be located at Turn 7 and as needed at the direction of the Driver Coach. Drivers who receive a black flag must report to the Driver Coach in pit lane.

TT TIMED SESSIONS: The session clock will start when the first car crosses the start/finish line and will continue to run during all flag conditions with the exception of the red flag.

RADIO FREQUENCIES: Reserved radio frequencies will be posted no later than Thursday at registration. These frequencies may be monitored but shall not be used for communication by any participant.

DISABLED CARS: Disabled or damaged cars may be removed from the course and delivered to a central location. Cars disabled due to a mechanical failure will be released to the driver/crew immediately. If the car requires wrecker support to return to its paddock location, there may be a delay depending on the availability of wreckers or flat tows. Hardship laps will be granted only at the discretion of the event lead.

TRACK LIMITS: Cars shall not cross the blend line at the exit of the pit lane whether approaching on the track or pit lane side. Violation of track limits may result in penalties.

TT RESULTS: Live timing will be available during the event. Unless otherwise announced, live timing will be available via the Race Monitor App available for iPhone and Android phones. Practice and unofficial final results will be posted at hospitality on the day of race. Final results will be posted to the MiDiv site no later than 14 days following the completion of the event.

TT AWARDS: Trophies for all races will be awarded in accordance with MiDiv TT rules section 12. Trophies will be presented at the event, personalized plates if used will be mailed post-event. TT points will be awarded for all races in accordance with the MiDiv TT rules section 12.

LAST LAP INDICATOR: When possible, a waving white flag will be displayed at Start/Finish to indicate the last lap.





SOCIAL EVENT: There will be a worker/competitor party Saturday evening at 6:00 pm and continuing on until Cahill passes out or Matt does his wing walk. Food and Drink will be served. Drivers, crews, and workers are encouraged to attend.

PADDOCK: Parking regulations are hereby incorporated in these regulations by reference. Failure to follow the direction of the Paddock Marshal or her/his designate regarding paddock parking or activities may result in expulsion from the facilities. All tow vehicles should nose into their row and empty into the driving lanes between the rows in the paddock. USE CAUTION, the speed limit in the paddock is less than 10 MPH! Be aware that pedestrians have the right away and may not see you.

CAMPING: Camping is allowed in the paddock on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights. Electricity is available in limited areas of the paddock. A charge for electricity may be assessed. Do not park in spaces where electricity is provided if you do not intend to connect, as the electricity charge will be assessed whether you connect or not. Please see registration upon arrival to secure a spot. Do not leave used tires at the track.

GENERAL RULES: The event will utilize the full 2.5 mile Grand Prix HMP road course in a counterclockwise direction. All drivers, crew and additional personnel must register in person. Access to the paddock is allowed outside registration hours by registering with the guard and showing your SCCA membership card. Drivers and/or entrants shall be responsible for the conduct of all individuals who have signed in through registration under the driver and/or entrant's name. This includes minors, guests, and pets. All individuals shall conduct themselves to the highest standard of behavior and sportsmanship. No consumption of alcohol shall be allowed until completion of race day activities (including in impound). Use of controlled substances or drugs shall not be permitted at any time. Per GCR 2.3.1. ATV's, bicycles, motor scooters/cycles are permitted in the paddock provided they are used in a safe manner and operated ONLY by licensed drivers. No such vehicles are allowed on track except as necessary for track officials. No minors on bicycles are allowed while the track is hot. No skate boards or roller blades are allowed. No person shall be admitted into HMP without the proper credentials from SCCA and track. Parental or guardian supervision of all minors is required. No race engines running before 7:00 am or after 10:00 pm.
