#### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

#### **ENTRY INFORMATION**

- 1. Event: This Endurance Series Championship Series event is governed by the current Midwestern Council General Competition Rules (MCSCC GCR) available at <a href="https://www.mcscc.org">www.mcscc.org</a> and these Supplementary Regulations.
- Race: The race length shall be the distance covered by the car completing the most laps upon crossing the Start/Finish line once 1.5 hours (90 minutes) of race duration has elapsed.
- 3. Team: Each team includes one (1) car and up to six (6) personnel (including up to four [4] drivers and crew).
  - 3.1. Over-the-wall crew MUST be 18 years of age or older unless a Minor Provisional Waiver (MPL) is on file.
- 4. Entry: The event will be limited to Fifty (50) cars.
  - **4.1.** Send the entry, and entry fee payment to:



- **4.2.** Entries and payment in full must be received by 11:59pm on Tuesday, June 27th. Entries received after June 27<sup>th</sup> may or may not be accepted.
- **4.3.** Checks should be made payable to Sports Car Club of Rockford or SCCR.
  - **4.4.** Cancellations must be made in writing (fax or email acceptable) on or before 11:59pm on Tuesday, June 27<sup>th,</sup> 2023 in order to receive a full refund. \$50 service fee charged for any cancelations after deadline. No refunds for any car that put wheels on track.
- **4.5.** MCSCC Permanent numbers will NOT be honored for the Endurance Series. Numbers will be assigned on a first come first served hasis
- 5. Classes: All closed wheel cars that meet MCSCC safety regulations as outlined in the current MCSCC GCR will be eligible to race.
  - **5.1.** There will be five (5) classes defined by a specific time brackets outlined in the chart below:

- 5.2. If a car goes faster than the quickest time for the class entered, that lap will be considered a break out and that lap will not be scored.
- 5.3. The entrant must declare their class before the start of the race, classes will not be allowed to be changed after the race has started.
- 6. Entrant: On the entry form each team will designate the person who will be both the pre-event and post-event person of contact.
  - **6.1.** Entrant need not be a driver or crew member for the team.
  - 6.2. Entrants attending the event must be listed as one of the six (6) allowed team members on the entry form.
- 7. Designated Team Representative (DTR): Each team will designate one member to serve as the team spokesperson during the event.
  - **7.1.** The DTR will be the only person who can officially speak for the team. It is recommended that the DTR have a thorough knowledge of the current MCSCC GCR, Car Specifications and these Supplemental Regulations.
  - **7.2.** An alternate DTR may be named should the listed DTR become incapacitated.
  - **7.3.** It is highly recommended that the DTR is available to the team during registration.
- 3. **Drivers:** Acceptable credentials for entrance in this event are:
  - 8.1. Midwestern Council Instructor, Full Competition, Novice, and Minor Participation licenses
  - 8.2. Midwestern Council Endurance Permit and Endurance Novice Permit
  - 8.3. Sports Car Club of America Pro, Full Competition, Novice (with one sign-off minimum) licenses
  - 8.4. BMWCCA Full Competition license
  - 8.5. WHRRI license
  - 8.6. EMRA license
  - 8.7. CASC license
  - 8.8. NASA (full) license
  - 8.9. PCA (full) license

- 8.10. ACC Level 1 and 2 licenses
- 8.11. SVRA or VMC racing licenses
- 8.12. VSCDA Driver Card (3 races experience minimum)
- **8.13.** FIA license Individuals from foreign countries MUST have a permission letter from their A.S.N. (issuing club) and a copy MUST be submitted with entry
- **8.14.** Other licenses to be evaluated on an individual basis by the event Chief Steward in consort with the Competition Director and Licensing Director.
- 8.15. Licensing questions must be resolved by Monday, June 26th.
- 9. Shift Duration: Each driver may drive for up to two and a half (2.5) hours duration in a single stint.
  - **9.1.** Drivers completing a 2.5 hour stint must remain out of the car for a minimum of one (1) hour before being allowed back in any car registered for the event.
- 10. Changing Teams: If any driver has his/her car permanently and OFFICIALLY withdrawn, by notification to the Chief Steward, he/she may be a relief driver for another team AFTER the change has been approved by the Chief Steward. The DTR for the team seeking the additional driver will accompany the driver changing teams to the Chief Steward for approval.
- 11. Penalties: Any penalties incurred by an individual driver or team member may be considered to have been incurred by the entire team at the discretion of the Chief Steward.
- 12. NO TEAM RADIOS ARE ALLOWED TO USE THE FOLLOWING FREQUENCIES: 151.625, 152.315, 154.514, 154.600, or 157.575 MHz.
- 13. Transponders: Minimum AMB Tranx 260 transponders are required for all entries. A limited number of transponders will be available for rental at registration. Rental is Fifty (\$50) dollars for the event and requires a five (\$500) dollar deposit. Rental fee and deposit requires cash or two (2) separate checks. Where to return rentals will be announced at the Driver/Team meeting.
- 14. Trophies: Trophies will be awarded to the top 30% of each class. SCCR can give out additional at their discretion.
- 15. Intoxicants: The consumption of intoxicants by any driver, crew or race official within the facility is forbidden until all on track activities have concluded for the day. This will be strictly enforced. If any driver or crew member is found to be partaking in intoxicants during the event, the entire team will be disqualified.
- 16. Pit rules, refueling rules, flagging rules: are all covered in the MCSCC GCR Enduro and General Competition rules.
- 17. Each entrant agrees that all photographs, videos, or other material of the entrant and/or entrants' vehicle can be used for promotional purposes by Sports Car Club of Rockford, Midwestern Council of Sports Car Clubs, Blackhawk Farms, and all race or series sponsors without prior written or verbal consent.

#### 2022 Blackhawk Farms Raceway Pit Vehicle Registration and Agreement

As dictated by our insurance carrier for 2022, Blackhawk Farms Raceway requires that all pit and other unlicensed or off-road vehicles have a season sticker displayed on the vehicle and a registration agreement on file with the Blackhawk Farms Raceway office.

In consideration for being permitted to utilize and operate a motorized pit vehicle on the Blackhawk Farms Raceway (BFR) premises at any 2022 season event or activity, the vehicle owner and/or competition entrant:

- Acknowledges and agrees that the vehicle shall be operated in compliance with the vehicle manufacturer's operating instructions and/or industry standards including those regarding riding/driving position and number of passengers.
- Hereby assumes full responsibility for and assumes the risk of bodily injury, death, or property
  damage arising out of or related to the use of said vehicles whether caused by the negligence of
  owner and/or their operators, Blackhawk Farms Raceway, other pit vehicle operators or otherwise.
- Acknowledges and agrees that all operators of said vehicles shall be at least 16 years old, have a
  valid state required driving license, and carry adequate general liability insurance applicable to the
  operation of their pit vehicles and that all operators shall provide such license, proof of insurance,
  and other applicable credentials upon request of a Blackhawk Farms Raceway or event official.
- Hereby acknowledges that the use of motorized pit vehicles is dangerous and involves the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage.
- Acknowledges that all registered pit vehicles MUST display the owner's competition vehicle number and registration decal in a clearly visible location at all times while on BFR grounds.
- Agrees that the pit vehicle will be operated in a responsible manner and according to all additional Blackhawk Farms Raceway regulations and instructions, including but not limited to posted speed limits, and hours of and allowed locations for operations.
- 7. Agrees that pit vehicles are not allowed on the competition track surface or hot pit lane at any time.
- Acknowledges and agrees that unsafe or improper operation of the pit vehicles and/or any violation
  of regulations and instructions may, at the sole discretion of Blackhawk Farms Raceway, result in
  penalties against the owner and/or operators including but not limited to immediate impoundment of
  the pit vehicle, loss of racing privileges for the event for a first offense, and for the season for the
  second offense.
