



Good afternoon AHRMA Family,

After much anticipation Barber Road Race Registration for 2022 is scheduled to open!

Respectfully, I request that you read this email in its entirety as very important information is located throughout the email.

1. Barber is a no refund / no credit event. Once registered, please do not ask for a refund or a credit.
2. Who is eligible to enter the road race event at Barber Motorsports Park when it goes live in MSR? *(Note: a-c entries will be taken into consideration when setting the race order.)*
  - a. AHRMA Members who have "Qualified" for Barber. "Qualified" is defined as members who have participated and completed at least two AHRMA road races over two separate weekends in 2022. Members are required to complete two full races, accepting the race-finishing flag, be it checkered or red.
  - b. International members in receipt of an exception email from the current Road Race Director.
  - c. Pro members in receipt of an exception email from the current Road Race Director.
  - d. Members registered for and planning to complete the qualification requirement at the Talladega GP. Our online registrar will confirm that the member is entered for Talladega and your entry will be marked as "Pending" in MSR.
3. Who must submit a waiver to be considered to race at Barber 2022?
  - a. Anyone who doesn't meet the "Qualified" definition in 2.a. All waivers should be submitted to [roadrace.director@ahrma.org](mailto:roadrace.director@ahrma.org).
  - b. Pro US Racers must submit proof of participation in at least two Pro 2022 road races from a recognized organization.
  - c. International racers must submit proof of participation in at least two 2022 road races and confirmation will be reasonably expedited.
  - d. Domestic racers, members who live within the USA, and failed to meet the qualifying requirements may submit a waiver request explaining their circumstance for consideration.
4. When can those members who receive a waiver register for Barber?
  - a. International members: as stated above in 2.b.
  - b. Pro members: as stated above in 2.c.
  - c. Domestic members: Not until after the initial entry period has closed and race order is set. As a reminder, entries will be capped at 600 race entries per day. A notification email will be sent once race order has been set with the time and date that registration opens in MSR for those granted waivers.

5. Important Waiver Facts:

- a. **ALL** riders (international, pro and domestic) granted waivers **MUST** practice **both** Thursday and Friday.
- b. Non-qualified members that inadvertently enter when the event initially goes live will be put on “Hold” and those entries will not be taken into consideration when officials set the race order. Additionally, if a waiver is not granted you **WILL NOT** be eligible for a refund or credit as the entry information in MSR clearly states that you should not register if you haven’t received a waiver.

6. Paddock Parking

- a. Last year Class Sponsorship contracts included the option to increase their sponsorship for a guaranteed Barber paddock spot. Jim Doyle, AHRMA’s Business Development Manager, has reached out to each sponsor who purchased this option to verify paddock parking location.
  - a. The map that’s posted on our Barber Paddock Request page (link in MSR when you sign up) shows only the paddock parking numbers that are available.
  - b. If you can’t see the number of the place you want to park because of a pink highlight that means the space has already been assigned.
- b. When submitting a paddock parking request, please refer to the space number(s) on written on the map. Since it’s possible that others will request the same spot, please include a range of space numbers when you submit your request.
- c. Paddock parking requests are to be submitted via the website as directed in the link from MSR. I am aware that some of you have contacted Michelle directly as she will once again be the manager of paddock parking; however, **requests for parking will be granted in order that a member registers in MSR**. Michelle will reference the date and time stamp included in MSR when members register. Simply, paddock parking spots will be assigned based on date/time of entry as captured in MSR.

7. Barber 2022 registration will open tomorrow, Friday, September 9<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 am central time.

8. Barber 2022 registration will close, Wednesday, September 21<sup>st</sup> at midnight central time.

9. The option to purchase a weekend pass will be available when you register to race. You may purchase weekend passes for racers, crew and family. Please **DO NOT** purchase tickets from Barber as they **CANNOT** be exchanged for our passes.
