## *Supplemental Regulations*

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**COVID Guidelines for all participants:** In light of the current COVID-19 situation every attempt will be made to minimize the risks of exposure to the virus. We will be following any and all local CDC guidelines at the time of the event. Ultimately, it is your responsibility to assess the risk to you, both on-track and off, and to make the decision on whether or not to participate. If you are feeling unwell or are experiencing symptoms such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath please stay home. If you have been in contact with someone who has tested positive or has been experiencing these symptoms in the last two weeks, please stay home.

While on site please take the health and safety of your fellow participants, volunteers and staff into consideration. At the time of the event we will be following any rules set forth by the local government, the CDC and CMP. We also ask that you continue to practice social distancing, wash your hands and/or use hand sanitizer frequently and wear a mask if you choose.

## *GENERAL RULES*

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**The Basics:** This event is governed by the 2021 SCCA Time Trial Rules (TTR), National Competition Format and National Classing as outlined at [timetrials.scca.com](http://timetrials.scca.com) plus the rules and procedures found on this page.

**Registration:** This event will be online registration only. You can register at MotorsportReg.com (direct link: <http://msreg.com/2021TimeTrial-TrackEvent>)

**Check-in:** Will be at the Registration building located just before the main gate on the right.

**Tech:** Will be located at the last garage bay closest to the track. If you DO NOT have advanced safety in your car (Advanced Safety = Aftermarket belts, seats, roll over protection, etc) you DO NOT need to bring your car to tech, just the tech sheet. If you DO have advanced safety, please bring your car and wait outside of the garage bay.

**Helmets-** If you have a 2017, 2018, 2019 or 2020 SCCA issued Helmet Sticker, be it from TT, TNiA, Solo, Road Racing or RallyX- you are good for this event. If you do not, you will be required to bring your helmet to tech.

**Paddock and Masks-** Everyone on site will be required to follow all CDC and CMP regulations and requirements at the time of the event. The areas and paddock in and around the garages, bathrooms and pit lane are all considered to be public spaces. We ask that you continue to be socially distant and to wear a mask if you feel as though you need to, unless guidance changes requiring face coverings. Areas and paddock space outside of that area (reserved camping spaces) are designated as distanced paddock where participants are encouraged to maximize the distances between one another and Personal vehicles, campers, enclosed trailers and tents are all considered to be personal spaces.

**Drivers Briefings-** We will have group drivers briefings at 8am Saturday and 7:40 Sunday morning. Drivers are required to attend one of these, but please do not feel like you need to be at more than one.

**Passing & Track Procedures:** Groups will use the suggested passing rules and procedures for Novice, Intermediate and Advanced Drivers as outlined in the "Rules of The Track" at [timetrials.sca.com](http://timetrials.sca.com).

**Clothing:** Drivers are required to wear the minimum clothing outlined in the SCCA Time Trials Rules for their car and class. Safe apparel must be worn in the pits at all times (shirts and closed toe shoes). Crew members on pit lane must display their event credentials at all times while on pit lane.

**Paced Laps:** Paced Laps are intended for Novice Drivers and Drivers who have never seen the track. Other drivers may join with permission of their group's driver coach if they join at the back and track density permits.

**Pit Lane:** The speed limit on pit road is 25 mph. No tire scrubbing in the pit lane prior to entering the course.

**Impound:** Drivers will report to impound for post-session debriefs immediately following each session.

**Results:** Provisional and final results will be posted at the Event Center. Additionally, final results will be posted no later than seven days following the completion of the event.

**Flag Procedures:** Black Flag Station and other event-specific flagging procedures will be announced at the event.

**Event Schedule:** Actual session start times may be delayed from the published schedule due to unforeseen circumstances during the event. It is the driver's responsibility to listen to the PA

system and pay attention to activity on track. The schedule or run groups may only be changed (or start times advanced) at the discretion of the Competition Director, with concurrence by the Event Lead, depending on pre-race entry counts or as needed to accommodate situations during the event.

**Communication:** Radio frequencies used by event officials may be monitored but shall not be used for communication by any participant.

## ***DRIVER ELIGIBILITY:***

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The event is open to all drivers with a valid state driver's license and a full or weekend membership to the SCCA. If you don't have a membership you can join or include the weekend membership when you register.

**TIME TRIALS LICENSES:** You are not required to have a license, but it's helpful if you do. Event officials will work with you to make sure you are issued one that aligns with your experience level at the event. This license is of no cost to you!

**MEDICAL:** Please notify the Officials of any pertinent medical condition(s). Any participants involved in an accident in which there is significant damage or any injury, or at a race official's discretion, MUST present themselves or be transported to the track medical facility for evaluation. Off-site medical transportation fees may apply.

**MINOR DRIVERS:** Drivers 17-years-old or younger can compete, but there is some extra paperwork so please contact Officials before the event and get approval from the Event Lead.

NOTE: All Convertibles, roll over protection is required, it is outlined in the safety link above, but if you have questions please ask prior to the event! We are happy to help!

Competition is open to all vehicles conforming to the National Time Trials Classes.

**TECHNICAL INSPECTION:** All vehicles must be presented at tech to turn in tech forms and pass the event safety inspection (Tech) if required prior to any on-course participation.

**TIMING & SCORING:** All cars registered for the Time Trial are required to use fully operational MyLaps transponders. The driver is responsible for providing correct information to Timing & Scoring. Non-functioning transponders will likely result in the loss of times. Those participating in the Track Event only will not be required to run a transponder.

**Transponders:** Need a transponder, we have you covered. Transponder rental is covered in your registration. If you have your own transponder, it must be a MyLaps transponder and we will request that you fill in the number when you register. For those registering for the Track Event, you will not be required to run with a transponder.

**Refunds:** You must contact the ambassador before the event is over if you are requesting a refund. No refunds will be granted if you turn a wheel on track at any entry point.

**Passes:** Anyone entering the track after registration hours must pay a fee of \$5.00 for a spectator pass and will not be issued a hot pass. No refunds will be given for spectator passes.

**AWARDS:** Will be given out on Sunday - No trophies will be mailed.

**Gate Hours:** The gate will be staffed from 4:00 p.m. Friday, September 17, 2021 to 7:00 p.m. Sunday, September 19, 2021. You must have a gate pass issued at registration or you can purchase a spectator \$5.00 pass to come in and enjoy the fun. Any registered driver and/or crew member arriving at the track before or after the listed registration hours will be allowed to enter the track upon signing a track waiver but, you'll have to return to registration to check in as a participant. Each driver will be allowed to register up to four (4) crew members that will also be issued a pass to enter at registrations.

**SOUND:** Sound level maximum is 105 dB and will be measured on the straight between Turns 3 and 4.

**Communications:** Race staff uses 456.4000 and 452.1000 MHz. Please do not use these frequencies for personal communication.

### **Carolina Motorsports Park Rules and Information**

**Speed Limit:** The speed limit in all non-competition areas including grid, paddock, and access roads is **10 mph**. Any driver or guest found to be in violation of this speed limit may be ejected by the event or track staff.

**Camping:** Camping is only available for selected days/events. You can find this info, as well as gates times, on the event listing on our calendar. General/tent camping is no charge. CMP has 15/20AMP receptacles throughout the facility at no charge – first come first serve. Clean, air-conditioned restrooms/showers are located centrally on the grounds. Camping quiet time begins at 10 pm.

**Paddock Roads:** No parking, repairing, or refueling vehicles or placing scales or jack stands on

any paddock road. These access roads are considered an Emergency Fire Lane by the Fire Marshall.

**Electrical Power:** 20 amp service is available without a fee. 30 amp service is available for a nominal fee through online booking at <https://www.carolinamotorsportspark.com/30amp-sites.html>

**RV Hookups:** RV hookups are not available at the track.

**Campfires:** Open campfires are NOT allowed. The use of fully enclosed grills is allowed.

**Fireworks/Firearms:** Fireworks, firearms, weapons and illegal drugs are strictly prohibited on the premises.

**Trash:** Trash receptacles are readily available throughout the facility. These can be easily identified as they are wrapped in "checkered flag" patterned plastic. Do not place any waste fluids or hazardous waste into the trash receptacles.

**Waste Fluids:** Waste disposal containers for oil and antifreeze can be found near the center of the paddock area.

**Gate Hours:** The gate will be closed overnight but will be staffed for re-entry into the facility. Participants and Guests will not be able to enter the facility after hours unless they have previously received a wristband.

**Garages:** Garages are available for rent. For pricing and availability please check online reservations at <https://www.carolinamotorsportspark.com/day-garages.html>

**Fire Extinguisher:** Each competitor must have at least one (1) portable BC dry chemical fire extinguisher of at least 10lbs and in good working condition in their pit area.

**Fuel:** Race fuel is not available for purchase from the track. Fuel can be purchased just outside of the track entrance (Independent gas station) and in the town of Kershaw (BP station).

**Pets:** Pets must be kept on a leash and not allowed to roam the paddock area. Pets are not allowed in any hot areas including grid, false grid, pit road, etc.

**Lake:** The lake is off limits to event participants/guests at all times. Fishing and swimming is not allowed in or around the lake at any time.

**Minors:** All minors must be under the supervision of a responsible adult. All minors must have a track minor waiver completed before they are allowed on site.

**Motorized Support Vehicles:** No pit bikes, dirt bikes or mini bikes are allowed on the premises without prior approval from the track management. Pit support motorized vehicles (ATV'S, golf carts, mopeds, motorcycles) may only be operated by a person with a valid driver's license and used only for race support. Car # must be displayed on support vehicle at all times. Unauthorized or dangerous use of these vehicles such as speeding, joy riding, or double riding will result in the vehicle being impounded and the driver reported to the Chief Steward.

**Grass:** Please do not damage the grass in any of the non-paved areas of the facility.

**Fences:** Fences may not be jumped or climbed in any area of the facility. Doing so is cause for expulsion from the track.

**Burnouts:** Performing Burnouts for tire warming or any other reason are **NOT** allowed in any area of the facility.

**Alcoholic Beverages:** No consumption of alcoholic beverages is allowed until after the last timed session of the day is complete.

**Signs/Notices:** Bulletin boards are provided by the restrooms, snack bar and timing and scoring building. Please do not tape notices to any painted surface, mirrors, guardrails, building walls, etc.

**Sunday Morning:** 11am during Quiet Hour
