# **Mike Kenney**

After serving the past two years as the St Louis Region SCCA Region Executive I have decided to remain on the ballot for the 2020 Region election of officers and Board of Directors members. The past two years have not been without significant challenges but the health of the Region remains good and progress has been made in many areas. The most significant challenge has obviously been the COVID-19 pandemic which continues to pose a significant threat still today. None of our programs were unaffected by the

pandemic which resulted in a large number of cancellations early in the season and many schedule changes as we resumed. In cooperation with the SCCA national office, local government agencies and venue managers we were able to resume our activities in early summer by establishing guidelines to enable the resumption of our events safely. I am currently a member of the St. Louis Region Board of Directors, "at-large," a position I have held for the last fifty-two months. I have also served as the region's Road Racing Chairman since August 2018.
