Dear Instructor,

Thank you for your commitment to instruct at our Windy City BMW High Performance Driving Experience (HPDE) at Blackhawk on Friday, August 1, 2026.

See the driver letter – attached- for the rest of the information on the experience, times, maps, sample waivers, car insurance option info, etc.

Red and yellow groups will have assigned instructors. You will have only one driver to instruct.

Run Group information:

There will be a Solo run group. Solo run group drivers are highly experienced HPDE participants. Eligibility for this run group will be decided by the DEC. The Solo run group will run in their own group.

Instructors will have their own run group scheduled during the day.

Instructor / Driver pairing assignment will be sent via email before the event. Please contact your driver ahead of time to discuss their goals, skill level, car modifications, previous track-driving experience, etc.

Technical Inspection: The form is attached. You must present the signed/certified tech inspection sheet at registration on the day of the event. You must sign the form as participant.

Your car must pass inspection before coming to the event. Your car must pass inspection before coming to the event. Use your normal dealer or independent shop technician familiar with your type of vehicle. There will be NO onsite inspections. There will be NO Chapter pre-tech event. Your vehicle’s status is subject to review by the event Tech Steward if questionable conditions are noted. No refunds are given if unsafe vehicles are

brought to the event. If in your role as an instructor you detect a safety issue with your student's car please alert the Chief Steward

The technical inspection is for your safety and the safety of others on the track with you. As this is a BMW CCA national requirement THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE.

Car: It must be in the car you registered in and must be quiet. If you have a change in cars after registering, notify Randy Everson.

Helmets: Helmets must be SNELL or SFI 2015 or newer. Helmets have to be checked at the track registration if you don't already have a current Windy City BMW inspection sticker (yellow or red).

Parking: There is minimal shade at Blackhawk. Do not park in front of the Pavilion or behind the ambulances.

At the front gate you will receive your packet with car number and schedule. You must sign the Blackhawk liability waiver and the one for Windy City BMW which sign away your rights and get your wristband. A copy of our waiver is enclosed, please review it. **If you have family or friends coming to the track, let Randy know 3 days ahead of time.**

Friday Morning: Registration from 6:45 till 7:45 at the front gate. Mandatory Instructor / Driver meetings at 8:00 by track start/finish. Drivers will then be introduced to their Instructors.

You can do a simple paddock check of your driver's car before the first time out on Friday morning. If you find any safety issues, let an event Chairperson know.

Miscellaneous

You will need a communicator, please be prepared and bring one.

All instructors must have a full operator's license that is not suspended or revoked. Equal restraints are needed. If you have a harness, then your passenger needs a harness. Cars must have mufflers in working order to run.

If you cause property damage at the track, you are responsible for the repair cost.

Driver Evaluation Form: One is enclosed to review. Refer to it as you work with your drivers to be sure all points are covered in your instruction. These are the areas of skills we most want to teach. We recommend that after your drivers' last track time you discuss their progress (or lack thereof) during the HPDE. The Committee reviews each evaluation to be able to place the driver in the appropriate run group at their next HPDE. Please let our Chief Instructor know if you instruct a driver who you feel has both the skills and the interest in becoming an instructor. They could be invited to attend a future Instructor Training School to keep our instructor base growing.

Important points:

* Keep a safe distance from the car in front of you except to pass.

- * If you or your driver has a 360 degree or more spin or four wheels off the track you must come into the pit area to be checked.
- * Racing will NOT be tolerated. ANYONE ENGAGED IN RACING WILL BE EXPELLED, NO EXCEPTIONS, NO REFUNDS.

Convertibles with folding hardtops are allowed, otherwise NO CONVERTIBLES WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE TRACK except with a hardtop and SCCA type roll bar/cage

Gasoline & Air: Air and fuel are available at the track (expensive) or 15 minutes away at normal pump prices.

Concession Stand: The concession stand will be open each day for lunch or you can go off-site. Your schedule has rest periods to allow time for you to eat.

TECH INSPECTION SHEET

This Inspection must include, but is not limited to, the following items. Additional items should be included as deemed necessary by the inspector to ensure the safe condition of the vehicle.

_____ **General:** No excessive body or chassis corrosion. No loose or improperly secured parts.

_____ **Battery:** Must be securely mounted and have no fluid leaks or corroded mountings.

_____ **Brake Fluid:** Must have adequate level and be in good condition. Brake fluid to have been changed within 6 months of the event. High quality fluid should be used. Brake pedal must not exhibit excessive travel.

_____ **Drive Belts:** Must be in sound condition and adequately tensioned.

_____ **Fuel and Coolant Hoses:** Must be in good condition and not exhibit cracks, swelling or other deterioration.

_____ **Mirrors:** Securely mounted. Vehicle must have at least an inside rearview mirror. Side mirrors are strongly recommended.

_____ **Pedals:** Must be securely mounted and exhibit free return. No interference from carpet.

_____ **Seatbelts:** At least a 3-point lap/diagonal, securely mounted in sound condition and with metal-to-metal buckles. Equal restraints are required for driver's and passenger's seats.

_____ **Seats:** Must be in sound condition and securely mounted.

_____ **Steering:** Must not exhibit looseness, play or binding throughout range of travel.

_____ **Suspension:** Mounting points must be secure and in sound condition. Vehicle must not have excessive side-to-side height variation. Shock absorbers must provide adequate damping and be securely mounted.

_____ **Throttle Linkage:** Smooth operation and free return without binding through entire travel.

_____ **Windows:** Must be secure and in sound condition. Any tinting must allow for proper vision.

_____ **Windshield Wipers:** Must be functional and in good condition.

_____ **Brakes:** Master cylinder must not exhibit excessive bleed-down when steady pedal pressure is applied. All brake lights must be working

_____ **Brakes:** Stock pads should have 50% or more friction material thickness. Hose and lines must not be cut, abraded or cracked. Rotors and drums must not be excessively worn.

_____ **Tires:** No cracks, blisters or cord evident. Front tires must be same size. Rear tires must be same size.

_____ **Wheel Bearings:** Properly adjusted with no excessive looseness or noise. No lubricant leakage.

_____ **Wheels:** No cracked or bent rims. Lug nuts or bolts must be tight.

_____ **Engine, Transmission and Differential Mounts:** Secure, without signs of deterioration or excessive play.

_____ **Leaks:** No coolant, brake fluid or fuel leaks. No excessive oil leaks.

_____ **Exhaust:** Must be securely mounted and in good condition.

_____ **Drive and Half Shafts:** Universal and CV joints must not have excessive looseness or exhibit leaks. Drive shaft flexible coupling must not exhibit cracks or other deterioration. Drive shaft center support bearing must not have excessive looseness or deterioration of its mounting.

_____ These or other items found to be unacceptable (explain):

The Event participant is solely responsible for the safe condition of the vehicle to be driven to, at and from this event. The vehicle must be inspected no earlier than four (4) weeks prior to the event. This must be done by a qualified individual chosen by the participant. The participant must sign this completed Pre-Event Technical Inspection Sheet at the time of inspection and present it at registration for the event.

I hereby certify that the above vehicle has been carefully examined by a qualified individual and that all the items have been checked. I understand that the safe condition and operation of this vehicle are entirely my responsibility. The BMW Car Club of America, Inc, and the Chapter and its members cannot be held liable or responsible for any vehicle and that problems, malfunctions or damage may occur in connection with the operation of this vehicle prior, during, or subsequent to the event.

2021 Blackhawk Farms Raceway Pit Vehicle Registration and Agreement

As dictated by our insurance carrier for 2021, **Blackhawk Farms Raceway** requires that all pit and other unlicensed or off-road vehicles have a season sticker displayed on the vehicle and a registration agreement on file with the **Blackhawk Farms Raceway** office.

In consideration for being permitted to utilize and operate a motorized pit vehicle on the **Blackhawk Farms Raceway (BFR)** premises at any 2021 season event or activity, the vehicle owner and/or competition entrant:

1. Acknowledges and agrees that the vehicle shall be operated in compliance with the vehicle manufacturer's operating instructions and/or industry standards including those regarding riding/driving position and number of passengers.
2. Hereby assumes full responsibility for and assumes the risk of bodily injury, death, or property damage arising out of or related to the use of said vehicles whether caused by the negligence of owner and/or their operators, Blackhawk Farms Raceway, other pit vehicle operators or otherwise.
3. Acknowledges and agrees that all operators of said vehicles shall be at least 16 years old, have a valid state required driving license, and carry adequate general liability insurance applicable to the operation of their pit vehicles and that all operators shall provide such license, proof of insurance, and other applicable credentials upon request of a **Blackhawk Farms Raceway** or event official.
4. Hereby acknowledges that the use of motorized pit vehicles is dangerous and involves the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage.
5. Acknowledges that all registered pit vehicles MUST display the owner's competition vehicle number and registration decal in a clearly visible location at all times while on BFR grounds.
6. Agrees that the pit vehicle will be operated in a responsible manner and according to all additional **Blackhawk Farms Raceway** regulations and instructions, including but not limited to posted speed limits, and hours of and allowed locations for operations.
7. Agrees that pit vehicles are not allowed on the competition track surface or hot pit lane at any time.
8.
