I. General

This is an easy-to-follow Touring Rally. It is the non-competitive event run on public roads at posted speed limits, following all traffic laws. This is <u>NOT</u> a race. Do not violate any traffic laws upon penalty of disqualification. Strict adherence to the National Road Rally Rules does not apply. This is a social event designed to have you enjoy an afternoon of driving through the area around Middletown, OH.

This rally is open to both SCCA members and non-members (a member discount is offered if at least one competitor is a current SCCA member).

II. Course

All roads are paved. Be mindful of patches of rough pavement, potholes, loose gravel in spots, and lawn clippings from mowing. The route goes through several areas of reduced speed limit and one lane bridges – please be mindful. Some roads have high speed limits (55). The course is approximately 75 miles. Insure your car number is written in the upper right of your instructions. Be mindful of the possibility of trains. All crossings are plainly marked. Where mileage is not given, the Callback Mileage is 3.5 miles.

TRAINS: Be mindful of the possibility of trains. All crossings are plainly marked. Please call the Rally Master if you need assistance, to report a problem or if you decide not to complete the rally.
