

## **Tour de North Rally**

**May 24 2025**

### **Supplementary Regulations**

#### **General Announcement**

The Rally Association of Vancouver Island (RAVI) will promote a Time/Speed/Distance Navigational rally on Saturday May 24<sup>th</sup> 2025.

The event will run 99% on paved surfaces with less than 1km being smooth gravel, and be approximately 150 km in total.

#### **Jurisdiction**

The rally is sanctioned by Rally Pacific Motorsports (RPM, the BC region of CARS), and follows the current BC Rally Regulations, which are posted here:

and C.A.R.S. General Competition Rules.

This is round #1 of our club series of 3 novice events for 2025.

#### **Required Equipment:**

One (1) self supporting reflective warning triangle (30cm per side), some will be available to borrow, but please bring your own if you have one.

Either a spare tire, or the factory equipped alternative.

Additional lights on the front should meet legal requirements as to type and mounting height, and must be wired to the high beam lights such that the additional lights turn off when switching to low beam. Fog lights may be wired independently.

All vehicles must be in compliance with all Provincial regulations for roadworthiness including the requirement for seat belts.

All vehicles will require a smart phone with the Richta Competitor App (<https://richtarally.com/>) loaded, & activated at the start with only the Competitor App running, and subsequently placed in the vehicle so that it always has a clear view of the sky. The Richta scoring system, which will be mixed with manual controls throughout, requires this app to be running. Hints for usage: <http://drscca.org/rally/using-therichta-competitor-app/>

### **Entry, Fees and Costs**

Registration will only be via MotorsportReg.com and includes payment. All involved, including competitors, and volunteers, are required to sign the required waiver(s) using the Motorsportreg waiver system, preferably at registration on MSR, but for sure prior to arriving at the event.

Entry fee: \$80 per car (driver and navigator required).

Maximum number of entries: 30 Car numbers, assigned in order of received payment.

Event officials reserve the right to reject any entry without recourse.

An entry may be withdrawn: (a) without penalty, up to 48 hours before the start of registration; (b) with up to 25% of the entry fee in penalty, less than 48 hours before the start of registration (percentage at organizer's discretion); (c) with up to 100% of the entry fee in penalty after the opening of registration (percentage at the organizer's discretion).

**Saturday May 24 2025, (8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) Day of Rally**, timing as follows

08:00 am Novice Orientation session, in White Spot parking lot (see VENUES below).

09:00 to 10:00 a.m. – Registration confirmation and Waiver confirmation.

09:00 to 10:00 a.m. - Technical Inspection followed by issuing of route books and car numbers.

10:00 a.m. - Drivers Meeting and introduction of officials.

10:30 a.m. - First Car Out.

4:00 p.m. - approximately, End of rally and distribution of results, at White Spot in Courtenay.

This tarmac Time Speed Distance navigational event starts from White Spot in Courtenay.
