Section 1: IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND DEFINITIONS

COMPETITORS

- o Individuals that are registered to drive at the event are Competitors.
- o All Competitors must be current SCCA Members or Weekend Members.
- o Competitors are also considered Participants.
- Competitors that are Minors:
 - Minors are eligible to drive at events provided they are legally licensed to drive. Drivers with a learner's permit must have a licensed adult ride along (see Passengers).
- Currently, our sites do not meet the minimum requirements to allow Junior Karts.

PARTICIPANTS (Invitee at BMP)

- Anyone with access to any "hot" area, including the active grid, staging, start, finish, trailer and course areas, whether driving or not, are considered <u>Participants</u> for insurance purposes.
- Individual sites may require everyone on premises to be a Participant, as determined by the Solo Safety Steward.
- All Competitors are required to assist in enforcing this rule.

PASSENGERS

- Passengers are allowed and must be SCCA Members or Weekend Member.
 - Weekend Membership is FREE for all non-driving Passengers.
- o Passengers must be no younger than twelve (12) years old or at least 57" tall.
- o Minor Passengers (under 19 years old) must have a properly completed the Minor Waiver.
- Competitors can ride with each other including riding BEFORE their competition runs.

SPECTATORS

- Spectators are NOT Participants or Competitors and are generally permitted access to the Paddock area and any area specifically designated as Spectator areas by the Solo Safety Steward – to reiterate, these are not "hot" areas.
- Spectators violating this rule may be required to leave the site upon request of the Event Chair.
- o Individual sites may forbid Spectators and require everyone on site to be a Participant.
- All Competitors are required to assist in enforcing this rule.
- All events at BMP are non-spectator events everyone is a Competitor or Invitee.

"HOT" AREAS

- Include the active grid, staging, start, finish, trailer, course areas or any other areas as designated by the Solo Safety Steward for insurance purposes.
- Non-Participants, children under 12 years old (or under 57" tall) and pets are not permitted in any "hot" area.

Section 2: WAIVERS

SCCA WAIVERS

- o In accordance with the SCCA insurance guidelines, all <u>Competitors</u> and non-competing <u>Participants</u> at or over the age of majority (*individuals under the age of 19 in Alabama are Minors*) must sign a "Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement" on site the day of the event or possess an Annual Waiver (<u>Annual Waiver</u>).
- Minors under 12, or otherwise, that are NOT Competitors or Participants are not required to have a Waiver.
- o Minors that are Competitors or Participants must have a completed Minor Waiver:
 - The form "SCCA Minor SCCA Official 1068 09/15" (found here Minor Waiver) must be completed. The first page is for BOTH parents / guardians to sign; the waiver is NOT an effective document WITHOUT BOTH parent / guardian signatures witnessed and signed by an adult SCCA member. The minor participant must sign the second page; this is a requirement of our insurer.
 - If one parent / guardian has full custody of the minor and no other parent / guardian has any claim to custody, the one signature is all that is required. The parent / guardian does NOT have to show any type of document to confirm custody.
 - If both parent will not be available on site the day of the event or if an SCCA Member is not available as a witness, this form may be used and it requires a notary Minor Waiver Notary
 - Once completed, the Minor Waiver is an Annual Waiver and a hard card will be produced from the national office. A second copy of the waiver form can be completed and held by the parent / guardian until hard card is received – this is strongly encouraged.

BMP WAIVERS

 Barber Motorsport Park has their own Waivers that will need to be signed before entering the facility. They also have a specific waiver for minors.

AGE OF MAJORITY

You not an adult In Alabama until you are 19 years old.
