



Code of Conduct

We are a Safe organization

Motor racing and track maintenance has many risks and we know that it takes all of us to stay safe.

1. We are responsible for maintaining our vehicles in safe operating condition, and ensuring our protective equipment is in working order. Drivers will not race with known safety issues.
2. The pre-race tech is not intended to find non-obvious deficiencies in car or equipment safety; this is the responsibility of the driver and car owner.
3. We encourage safety interventions from our fellow members, and accept them with a thank you.
4. If we are not sure about something, we will ask. We recognize that every member had different experience and we are here to help each other.
5. We will intervene with spectators when they are at risk.
6. We respect the cold track; the track is always cold unless there is a planned event. Test and Tune events can be set up with short notice.
7. We will not be impaired or consume intoxicants during race events, and comply with legal limits when we leave the site.
8. During events, the Head Race Official has the final say on all matters of safety and conduct at the site.

We are a Respectful organization

While we are rivals for position on the track, when the race is over we have each other's back.

1. We appreciate that this sport is expensive and will do the best we can to mitigate damage to all members' cars and other property in the pits; this includes the removal of cars and parts from the track.
2. We appreciate the privilege of having this facility available to us and follow the rules set out by governing bodies for the use of the lease and the activities we engage in. Here are a few important examples:
 - i. We follow the Area 63 Motorsports Park Facility Use Rules
 - ii. We sign off our waivers, tech sheets and other paperwork as required
 - iii. We do not put wildlife at risk by leaving attractants on the site unattended – it is removed or stored safely when we leave the site for the day; this includes all fuels, food, other garbage
 - iv. We do not bring glass containers to the site, and do not dispose of them in waste bins.
 - v. We do not operate/ have non-members on the site after dusk, unless appropriate lighting is in place
 - vi. We do not park on the roadway or have any other activity that occurs off of our lease (without the specific permission, in writing, from another lease-holder in the area for that use)
3. There is zero tolerance for behaviour that disrespects Officials, volunteers or other racers and their crews.
4. We will follow the Bylaws of the Society and address any disagreements through the channels provided.
