1. General:-

- 1. This event is governed by the 2022 SCCA General Competition Rules (GCR) and "FasTrack" effective July 1, 2022 release and these supplemental regulations. This is a Great Lakes Division Regional Championship Series event. Series rules for series classes are available on the GLD Website www.gldscca.com.
- 2. Event will be open to all drivers holding a valid SCCA membership & licensed per GCR 3.1.2 of 2022 GCR. Registrar is not able to verify licenses issued by other clubs, you will be responsible to provide current license.

Entry Fee - Includes 2 crew passes (no additional passes will be available):

Both Days - \$395 One Day only - \$225

Both days events (1 car, 1 driver, 2 classes) - \$650

SRF, SRF3, FE, FE2/race compliance fee/ weekend \$30

- 3. LATE FEE POLICY There will be a late entry fee of \$50 assessed to all entries received once registration opens at the track. This is a rule that has been implemented by Great Lakes Division in 2018.
- 4. <u>In order to keep the entry fee down trophies may be distributed after the event.</u> <u>Make sure the Race Chair has</u> <u>your contact info</u>.
- 5. Drivers and Entrants are responsible for their crew.
- 6. Everyone entering a HOT area must be an SCCA member and must wear the valid HOT credential issued for this event. Weekend SCCA memberships will be available at Registration for a cost of \$15.00.
- 7. DRONES AT THE RACE TRACK Commercial Unmanned Aircraft System (aka "Drone") owners/operators must have proof of FAA certification and \$10M of primary liability insurance naming the SCCA, the Sponsoring Region(s) and the Race Track as additional insured. A general liability insurance policy must specify that it includes the operation of Unmanned Aircraft. Recreational use of unmanned aircraft is prohibited. SCCA 2.2.6
- 8. Neohio SCCA strive to ensure that ALL participants in its events and activities enjoy a welcoming environment. We support equality of opportunity and treatment for all participants and will make every effort to maintain an environment that is free of harassment, discrimination, and any behavior that interferes with a safe, fun, and exciting experience. A commitment to a welcoming environment and the SCCA Values is expected of all its members and attendees, including drivers, workers, crew, guests, staff, contractors and exhibitors, and other participants at SCCA activities, sessions and social events and when representing SCCA in print or electronic media.
- 9. Friday Test Day is not an SCCA sanctioned event. Please contact the track for further information.

2. Registration:

- 1. Event Registration: All participants MUST register online at <u>www.motorsportreg.com</u>.
- 2. License & proof of membership must be presented at Registration. You are urged to have an Annual Waiver on file at SCCA. Drivers needing license and/or membership confirmation must contact the Registrar no later than 9 PM WEDNESDAY, July 6, 2022; a \$10 fee will be charged for this service. Membership and license issues will not be able to be verified with the SCCA National Office after 5:00 PM CST on Friday night. After that time, the National Office will be closed until Monday morning. If your membership and/or license cannot be verified, you will be required to complete and sign a Statement of Fact Affidavit along with paying a \$100 deposit, of which \$75 is refundable upon verification.
- 3. Telephone & online entries are **not official until the entry form is signed**, **accepted**, **and all fees are received**. Personal checks, money orders, or cash only will be accepted at the track. A \$50 charge will be assessed on any check returned. The **Chief Registrar** will not be responsible for any entries sent that require a signature or special pick up. If paying by check

it must be mailed 5-7 days after registering online or entry will be considered late.

- 4. Each race group will be limited to 55 cars; after that number is reached entrants will be placed on a waiting list for their respective group.
- 5. Drivers, crew & workers must register before the close of Registration signing an SCCA waiver & issued a wristband. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action against the responsible driver. Wristbands & SCCA photo IDs MUST be worn at all times. You are urged to have an Annual Waiver on file at SCCA.
- 6. Car Numbers will be issued on a first come first served basis, postmark will be used. Registrar will notify those who do not receive their first choice of car number.
- 7. Cancellations must be in writing. E-mail cancellations are acceptable. Full refunds will be given to those entrants who cancel before 9 PM, Tues., July 5, 2022. A \$50.00 administrative charge will be assessed to cancellations after that date. No refund will be provided for cancellation requests after August 1, 2022. No refunds will be given to any car that turns a wheel on course.
- 8. There will be **NO** Late Entry Registration until one hour after posted Registration opening times, Friday and Saturday.

3. Conduct of the Event:

- 1. There will be no waivers on any safety related equipment.
- 2. The Black Flag station for this event will be at Start/Finish and may be at Station 10.
- 3. Class rules for SP, SPU, ITE, CFC, CFF, S2, GTA & IT7 are published on the Great Lakes SCCA Division website under Champ Series Rules <u>www.gldscca.com</u>.
- 4. Sports R (SR) rules: Sports R is for all Sports Racers powered by Renault engines. See Neohio Rules at https://neohioscca.com/club-racing-rules-update/
- 5. V8 Road Racing Series: Certain classes that race within the Large Bore racing group are eligible for points toward the V8RRS championship. For more information please see their website at https://www.v8rrs.com
- 6. Sound level for Nelson Ledges is 103 dbs. Sound reading will be measured on the outside of turn 13.
- 7. The Start/Finish line extends through pit lane and will be used for all Timing and Scoring. A working AMB <u>TRANX 260, TR2 or</u> <u>TR2</u> Transponder on each car is mandatory. You will not be scored if it is not working properly. Correct transponder number needs to be provided.
- 8. Operation of 2-way radios on the following frequencies is not permitted: 151.760, 462.5625, 464.500 and 456.800, these frequencies are for event official use only.
- 9. CONTACT: All on track body contact (including contact during drafting) that causes a car to act erratically and results in a change in position or a car leaving the course will be investigated. All drivers involved must report to the Chief Steward during the 30-minute Impound for their group. Drivers who do not satisfy this requirement will be referred to the Stewards of the Meet.
- 10. **PASSES UNDER YELLOW FLAG:** All passes under yellow reports will be investigated. All drivers shall follow GCR Section 6.1.1B. A violation of this section will result in penalties as outline in the 2022 Standard Penalty Guidelines.
- 11. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited in the paddock **by anyone** until the end of the entire day's final race activity.
- 12. Damage to property not covered by SCCA insurance will be back billed to person causing damage.

4. Track Policies and Services

- 1. Wristbands provided at Registration must be worn at all times. Participants without wristbands will not gain entry or will be asked to leave the track. Drivers will not be allowed on course without the wristband in place and will be checked by the grid marshals. Replacement wristbands are \$10.00.
- 2. Only ONE crew member may stand at the pit wall to signal the driver at the discretion of the Chief of Pits.
- 3. Riding on the outside of any vehicle or trailer is prohibited.
- 4. Two, three and four-wheeled vehicles are prohibited, except for race officials or as race support vehicles. No joy riding. Driver must be at least 18 and have a driver's license issued by their home state. All race support vehicles must prominently display the approved racecar number and class.
- 5. Un-muffled engines shall not be operated between 8:00 p.m. and 7:30 am.
- 6. Pets must be restrained AT ALL TIMES & attended by an adult. Clean up after your pet.
- 7. Camping is permitted for a fee specified by track management. Hookups are not available. Campfires must always be contained and attended by an adult at all times. No accelerants may be used.
- 8. Competitors must remove all tires and used automotive fluids from the premises. Please clean your area before departing.
- 9. Contact the track prior to the event about available fuels. Any team with more than 40 gallons of fuel must notify the Safety Steward and Chief of Emergency Services as to their paddock location.
- 10. No testing of race cars off the track premises or side roads.
- 11. Traffic on bridge will be for passenger vehicles only. No auto or foot traffic while cars are on course.
- 12. Motorhomes and semi-trailers owners are requested to contact the track prior to the event for parking locations. 330-977-0111
- 13. Food concession may be available.
