



1. All Province of Manitoba health guidelines will be followed.
2. These COVID-19 regulations are an addendum to the official supplemental regulations for WSCC Winnipeg Autoslalom and may change without notice.
3. If there is a conflict between the official 2020 Supplemental Regulations and this COVID-19 Addendum, the regulation(s) stated in this addendum should be considered in force and correct.
4. The Winnipeg Sports Car Club (WSCC) is not responsible or liable for any illness that a person may acquire from attending an event.
5. SCCA COVID-19 amendments from this URL will be enforced for all events while health restrictions are in place: <https://www.scca.com/pages/solo-1588021531-21>
6. Registration may open and close with less than 14 days notice.
7. If anyone looks unwell they will be asked to leave immediately:
 - a. There will be no allowance for flu, cold or allergies. If you look sick, you will be asked and expected to leave.
 - b. There will be a screening at the gate, please be patient as we get people onto the site.
8. Refunds or credits will be provided up to the start of an event. If you are sick do not come!
9. **UPDATE:** Ride alongs are permitted only if riders are from the same household.
10. Depending on the number of rookies registered, the Guided Course Walk will only proceed if social distancing measures can be maintained.
11. **UPDATE: In-car instruction will be available.** The Instructor and participant must agree and consent to the ride along. The Instructor will sanitize hands before entering and after exiting the vehicle. After the run is over, the Instructor will exit the vehicle and continue instruction from outside the vehicle. It is strongly recommended that the participant and Instructor wear nonmedical masks under their helmets.

This change is based on the Province of Manitoba guidelines that state: "Minimize prolonged (more than 10 minutes), close (less than two meters/ six feet) contact between your co-workers and other individuals in public." 12. Rookies must attend the Guided Course Walk in order to race, however in the event that the Guided Course Walk cannot be held (see item 10), Rookies will be allowed to race.
13. Helmets are mandatory. Bring your own helmet.
14. Bring your own lunch, there will be no food vendor.





15. Registration requirements:

- a. Online registration and payment at Motorsportreg.com is required.
- b. Registration will close at 11 PM CST the night before the event.
- c. Events will require a minimum of 20 registered drivers prior to early bird registration closing or the event will be canceled at that time. Actively registered drivers will get a refund.
- d. Events will allow a maximum of 100 drivers/spectators.
- e. Cash payments will not be accepted.

16. Use of nonmedical masks when not driving or in your car alone is strongly recommended.

- a. Masks and other Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) will not be provided by the WSCC.

17. **UPDATE:** Radios will only be handled by station captains and will be wiped before each exchange.

The person picking up and dropping off the radio will wipe it down on return.

18. We recommend marshals carry hand sanitizer and do not touch their face after handling cones on track.

This is the responsibility of the participant and not the WSCC.

19. Only one person in the timing trailer at a time.

20. Maintain recommended social distancing protocols in the pits.

- a. Offenders will be asked to leave immediately with no refund.

21. Points will be collected for each event. However, due to the uncertainty of the number of events we will run there will be no championship or trophies this year at this time. This may change as the season progresses.

22. **UPDATE:** Total runs will be **4 official**, rotating between run groups. After the initial 4 runs of each run group are completed, there will be a drivers meeting at which time running an additional **3 unofficial bonus** runs will be decided upon. Additional runs will only commence if 12 or more registered drivers agree to participate.





23. UPDATE: '+1 for Free' Promotion:

Bring a +1 friend who qualifies as a novice driver (less than 8 autocrosses driven lifetime), and they will race for free!

- a. Promotion eligibility applies to active annual WSCC members in combination with a novice autocross driver.
- b. The registering active WSCC member must contact Winnipeg Autoslalom registration through Motorsportreg.com and provide the +1 friend's full name, car year/make/model, and car class. They will be assigned a number by registration.
- c. The active WSCC member and +1 friend must register before the early bird deadline expires, (11 PM CST 2 days prior to the event).
