Thank you for volunteering for the Windy City BMW Club Blackhawk High Performance Driving Experience (HPDE). For overall information we have provided some info from the Driver Packet to you. Look over the attached Waivers, you will need to sign at the track.

You will be scheduled to assist at morning registration and/or at pit-out (if you are 18 or older). Registration consists of verifying paperwork, checking helmet sticker (Windy City current yellow or green ribbon), etc. Pit-out workers ensure drivers are going out in the correct run group and have seatbelts and helmets secured, etc. Final assignments will be emailed to you in the week before the event. A printed copy of your schedule and the overall event schedule will be given to you on-site. We can't do this driving program without you, so...

The following info is provided to acquaint you with our program in case you need to field questions from drivers at the track. Many of the specifics are applicable mostly to our Drivers.

Wrist band colors will be: instructors –drivers– green, autocrossers - yellow, workers and staff - purple.

Special Run Group information:

- There will be combined Solo/Instructor driver run group(s). Eligibility for this run group will be decided by the Driving Events Committee. These participants will have three open track sessions with unlimited passing zones with all passing requiring a point-by signal. The fourth session will be either an open track or a series of standing start timed laps. The driver must designate which option prior to the HPDE.
- The other participants will be experienced Windy City BMW autocrossers vetted by the Autocross Chairman. These participants will have three on-track sessions including 2 or 3 passing zones with all passing requiring a point-by signal. The fourth session will be a series of timed laps.

Cancellation Policy: If you have to back out after registering, please call Randy Everson (847-274-7129) ASAP and let him know you are not coming.

Technical Inspection: Drivers & autocrossers must present a signed/certified Tech Inspection Sheet at Registration. **There is NO onsite inspection.** The technical inspection is for everyone's safety on the track. As this is a BMW CCA national requirement THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE.

Helmet: Must be Snell or SFI 2010 or newer. Helmets need to be checked. Participants will bring helmet to the morning registration to get the helmet teched **unless they already have a current Windy City BMW sticker (yellow or green)**. <u>Absolutely NO</u> open-faced loaner helmets will be available on loan from the Chapter.

Registration from 7:00 AM till 7:30 AM. You should arrive at the track by 7:00. At the front gate you must sign the Autobahn liability waiver. At Registration you will sign the one for Windy City BMW and the WC Covid Waiver which sign away your rights and get your wristband. A copy of our waivers are enclosed, please review them. Registration will be held just outside of the entrance gate.

At 8:00 AM there will be a drivers' and autocrossers' Safety Meetings near the Pavilion. This is the most important safety meeting of the day and is MANDATORY for them.

Parking at Blackhawk: Park anywhere within the paddock area except in front of the Ambulance or the Concession Building. If Covid is still an issue, leave a car's width between your car and your neighbor's.

INSURANCE REGULATIONS:

Racing will NOT be tolerated. ANYONE ENGAGED IN RACING WILL BE EXPELLED, NO EXCEPTIONS, NO REFUNDS.

Covid Etiquette: You will be required to wear your own mask and maintain social distancing.

Track Familiarization: At the beginning of the day, there will be track familiarization for those drivers who have not been to Blackhawk before. This is just touring, and no helmets are required. Maximum speed is 50 and there is no passing. There will be pace cars dempnstrating the proper line.

Weather: Who knows about the weather? Please come prepared for the worst. Try to pack your things (rain gear, clothes, spare parts, etc.) in waterproof containers (like Rubbermaid Roughnecks) or bring a tarp or big plastic bags because your car will be unpacked in whatever the weather.

Gasoline & Air: Air and fuel are available at the track (expensive) or 20 minutes away at normal pump prices.

Concession Stand: The concession stand will be open at 7:00 AM for coffee and breakfast. You will also be able to buy your lunch. The food is really good. Your schedule has rest periods to allow time for you to eat.

Paddock: The paddock (parking) area has no shade. Bring skin protection and a canopy, if you have one.

Note that Marijuana products are illegal at Blackhawk. Please don't bring any with you.

2021 Blackhawk Farms Raceway Pit Vehicle Registration and Agreement

As dictated by our insurance carrier for **2021**, **Blackhawk Farms Raceway** requires that all pit and other unlicensed or off-road vehicles have a season sticker displayed on the vehicle and a registration agreement on file with the **Blackhawk Farms Raceway** office.

In consideration for being permitted to utilize and operate a motorized pit vehicle on the **Blackhawk Farms Raceway (BFR)** premises at any **2021** season event or activity, the vehicle owner and/or competition entrant:


- Acknowledges and agrees that the vehicle shall be operated in compliance with the vehicle manufacturer's operating instructions and/or industry standards including those regarding riding/driving position and number of passengers.
- Hereby assumes full responsibility for and assumes the risk of bodily injury, death, or property
 damage arising out of or related to the use of said vehicles whether caused by the negligence of
 owner and/or their operators, Blackhawk Farms Raceway, other pit vehicle operators or otherwise.
- 3. Acknowledges and agrees that all operators of said vehicles shall be at least 16 years old, have a valid state required driving license, and carry adequate general liability insurance applicable to the operation of their pit vehicles and that all operators shall provide such license, proof of insurance, and other applicable credentials upon request of a Blackhawk Farms Raceway or event official.
- Hereby acknowledges that the use of motorized pit vehicles is dangerous and involves the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage.
- Acknowledges that all registered pit vehicles MUST display the owner's competition vehicle number and registration decal in a clearly visible location at all times while on BFR grounds.
- Agrees that the pit vehicle will be operated in a responsible manner and according to all additional Blackhawk Farms Raceway regulations and instructions, including but not limited to posted speed limits, and hours of and allowed locations for operations.
- 7. Agrees that pit vehicles are not allowed on the competition track surface or hot pit lane at any time.
- 8. Acknowledges and agrees that unsafe or improper operation of the pit vehicles and/or any violation of regulations and instructions may, at the sole discretion of Blackhawk Farms Raceway, result in penalties against the owner and/or operators including but not limited to immediate impoundment of the pit vehicle, loss of racing privileges for the event for a first offense, and for the season for the second offense.

- Pit Vehicle Passes are \$25 for the season or \$10 for a single event.
 Participants must register their pit vehicle in the Pit Stop. Please see the attached Pit Vehicle Registration and Agreement form.
- The cost for electric is \$25 for a weekend event or \$10 for a single weekday event. Participants must purchase an electrical tag at the Main Gate or in the Pit Stop. Those that plug into electric prior to purchasing an electric tag, will be charged \$30 for a weekend event or \$15 for a weekday event.

Note that "pit vehicles" do not include electric skateboards or 2-wheeled items like bicycles or motor scooters.
