PAYMENTS AND REFUNDS

Payments will be processed at the time of check-in at the track. Cancellations should be made prior to the event.

- All drivers, Volunteers, and Crew must check in and sign the SCCA waiver to get event credentials.
- Refunds will be considered for cars that have not been on the racing surface. Requests must be submitted to the Chief Registrar.
- After the event is complete, refund requests must be made to the treasurer Teresa.massey54@gmail.com within 7 calendar days.
- SCCA membership is required for access to Hot Areas. Proper credentials and event wristbands as provided by the region must be visibly displayed in all hot areas. Weekend membership can be purchased during registration hours (\$25.00).

DRIVER INFORMATION

DRIVER ELIGIBILITY: Participants are required to show a government-issued driver's license and an Annual or Weekend SCCA membership at check-in. Purchase an annual membership at www.scca.com. Weekend memberships can be purchased during online registration.

CAR ELEGIBILITY: Time Trials: CAR ELEGIBILITY: A signed TT Tech Form is required before your car can go on track. Please see the Time Trial Event Lead to have your car inspected during the TT Tech times and location as listed on the schedule.

EVENT ENTRY STANDARDS: Any information provided during event registration or displayed on an entered car, including, but not limited to, sponsor names, car names, car designs, and graphics—that is deemed vulgar, offensive, or inconsistent with our core values will be considered a violation of the SCCA Welcoming Environment. The SCCA reserves the right to remove such information from the registration system or request that participants remove offending designs/graphics from their vehicles. Repeating offenses may result in further action. Please note that event results and images are shared online and with our partners, and we expect all entries to reflect our values of respect, excellence, and inclusiveness.

MEETINGS: Participants must attend the Mandatory Time Trials Driver Meeting at the time and location listed on the schedule. In addition, drivers will attend a short debrief with the group's Designated Driver Coach after each on track session.

EVENT SCHEDULE / RUN GROUPS: The course configuration for this event will be Clockwise. The event schedule is published for planning purposes. Session start times may vary from the published schedule as the event progresses. Run groups may be changed at the discretion of the TT Event Lead. If changes are made, as much notice as possible will be given to all competitors.

TIMING AND SCORING: All cars are required to use MyLaps (formerly AMB) transponders. Drivers are responsible for providing correct information during registration. Non-operational transponders or missing transponder information may not be scored for the event.

- A limited number of transponders may be available for rent - \$30.00 per day, along with a \$500 retainer on a valid credit card.
- The clock will continue to run during all flag conditions, except for the red flag.
- Personal timing beacons are not allowed within 20 feet of the T & S system, or across track from start/finish.

GRID: Starting positions will be determined by the group's designated driver coach. Crew and guests must leave the grid at the one-minute warning. Drivers are not allowed to scrub tires in the paddock, grid, pit-out or hot pit lane.

DISABLED CARS: Disabled or damaged cars may be removed from the course and delivered to a central location. If the car requires wrecker support to return to its paddock location, there may be a delay depending on the availability of wreckers or flat tows.

FLAGGING: The BLACK FLAG station is corner 6. GCR 6.1 flag rules apply to all sessions.

AWARDS: Results and trophies will be available in the hospitality area. Trophies not picked up will be considered forfeited unless prior arrangements have been made with the Event Lead. Only participants with an Annual SCCA membership will be eligible for points towards any Annual Championship Series.

Paddock: Time Trials participants are encouraged to paddock together in the TT Corral (raised paddock South of the Classroom).

Access ways for general paddock traffic and emergency vehicles must be always kept clear or vehicles will be towed.

- A. You must have a valid motor vehicle license, novice permit, or competition license to operate any 2, 3, or 4-wheeled motorized or non-motorized vehicles in the paddock.
- B. Skateboards, skates, rollerblades, and one-wheel electric boards are prohibited.
- C. The paddock speed limit is 10 M.P.H. Vehicles in the paddock must be operated in a safe manner.
- D. Entrants are responsible for the conduct of their crew, guests, minors, and pets. All minors must always be under direct adult supervision. Pets in the paddock must be always leashed and under the direct supervision of an adult.

GENERAL: Participants must always display proper credentials and event wristbands as provided by the region. Minors and non-members must remain behind any barrier paralleling the hot pit lane. No one will be allowed to view from in front of the race control and timing structure.

- A. If an event or part of the event is postponed or cancelled, entry fees will be refunded to those offered no opportunity to compete.
- B. Consumption of alcohol is prohibited until after the daily on track activities are concluded. GCR 2.3.1.B shall be in effect as it relates to Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs.
- C. The organizers reserve the right to refuse entry and/or issuance of credentials to the premises or event for any reason except race, color, creed, sex, or national origin.
- D. Unmanned aerial vehicles, also known as drones, shall not be used anywhere in the airspace over the property.
- E. Vendors wishing to display or sell any items must obtain prior approval from the race chair.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Test and Tune: The track may be open for Test and Tune prior to the event. Please contact the Track Manager, Allan Lasater at Allan@lajuntaraceway.net for pricing and information. **Please Note: Any Open Lapping, Test Day, or Session not on the official schedule are NOT sanctioned by SCCA and are NOT covered by SCCA Insurance.**

Race Fuel: The only fuel available on the track property is offered at La Junta Municipal Airport with a self-serve pump (credit card only). Loaf n Jug is about 2.5 miles south of the track.

Directions to La Junta Raceway: La Junta Raceway is on Route 109 (Main Street) about four miles north of US-50 in the Airport Industrial Park. Enter at the main Industrial Park entrance (Harris Ave.) and follow Harris to the end. Turn left on First Avenue, then left again on Railroad Avenue. The track entrance is on the right.

Accommodations: RVs may be parked overnight at the track. A limited number of electrical hookups are available for rent on a first come basis through the Track Manager, Allan Lasater at Allan@lajuntaraceway.net.

Volunteer Incentives: Volunteers are required to pre-register on MsReg. Volunteer lunches will be provided.

Additional Incentives:

- Volunteers can participate in one Free TT session each day, as coordinated by the worker's specialty chief and the TT Lead.
