PRACTICE DAY SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

This event is held under the 2020 General Competition Rules, based on the 2020 GCR and Category Specifications, as published by the Sports Car Club of America, and as amended for 2020 per "FASTTRACK".

COVID-19 Statement: ALL those attending this event and entering the facility will be required to use caution regarding the spread of this virus, use personal protective equipment and maintain social distancing as required by State and local government regulations and those of Sebring International Raceway and the SCCA or CFR-SCCA in effect at the time of this event. As the status of the pandemic evolves, all participants entered will be notified via email, written drivers meeting or official social media posts regarding the change in requirements and what the expectations of all participants will be. All in attendance are reminded to be respectful of others and follow these regulations. Personal Protective Equipment - Sebring International Raceway (SIR) may require all attendees to wear face covering sufficient to cover their nose and mouth and adhere to social distancing guidelines while on SIR property. Attendees not adhering to these requirements will be given one warning to comply. On behalf of SIR. Central Florida Region will require non compliant individuals to leave the facility. This action is not protestable. If you are diagnosed with COVID-19 within two weeks of this event, we ask that you notify the event Race Chair immediately.

Conduct of the Practice day will be in accordance with the 2020 GCR. The Chief Steward is authorized to make schedule adjustments based on the progression of the event. The Chief Steward will make the final determination as to eligibility and conduct of participants.

Practice Day participants participating in the Members Memorial Majors and SARRC events will receive their credentials for the entire weekend during Practice day registration.

Car Groupings for Practice day may be revised based on early registration received. It is anticipated that all four sessions for each group with be 25 minutes in duration, unless uncontrollable circumstances dictate changes as decided by the Chief Steward. Time spent cleaning up debris from a session will result in a reduction of time for that group in subsequent sessions.

All sessions will end with a checkered flag displayed at start finish, followed by a black flag at all stations. Please proceed directly to pit-in. This will allow maximum track time for all competitors. Drivers running the checker will forfeit half of his/her next session.

REGISTRATION: ALL DRIVERS MUST PRE-REGISTER THERE WILL BE NO LATE ENTRIES OR CHANGES MADE AT THE TRACK! Drivers can register for the race and practice day events online at www.motorsportreg.com. Drivers without internet access must complete a paper entry form and mail with entry fees to: Sharon Priep, 2824 Salisbury Blvd., Winter Park, FL 32789. Make checks payable to Central Florida Region, SCCA. Second drivers must submit separate entry form and entry fees. A bank service fee will be charged for any check returned by the bank. A full refund will be made if the entry is withdrawn prior to Tech or if a no show. If you check in at on-site registration and do not go to, or pass Tech, you must notify the Chief of Registration, BEFORE YOU LEAVE THE TRACK, in order to receive your refund. Requests for refunds made after the event is over will be made in the form of a credit, valid toward a future CFR race event, in the amount of the applicable entry fee, less \$20. Do not mail entries/checks by any method that requires a signature upon delivery.

ENTRY FEE PAYMENT: Drivers who complete their registration online, via the motorsportreg.com website, will be required to enter credit/debit card information. Cards will not be charged until after the event. Drivers wishing to pay by check, must send their check to the registrar within five (5) days of completing online registration, however it must be received by the registrar prior to the close of online registration. Cash and checks will not be accepted at the track. Credit/Debit Card payment option is available only for those drivers/entrants who complete their registration online. Credit cards will not be accepted for drivers submitting paper entries.

DRIVER ELIGIBILITY: To participate in this event, all drivers must be a member of the SCCA and must have a current SCCA Full Competition license, SCCA Pro license, or a valid SCCA Novice Permit with school requirements completed. If you do not have the proper credentials it is your responsibility to contact the Registrar prior to the event. Registration will not be able to handle license and membership issues at the track. Novice Permit Holders must display, in a contrasting color, a minimum 5-inch tall "X", next to the car number on each side and on the rear of the car.

PASSES: Each entry receives six (6) passes, INCLUDING THE DRIVER AND ENTRANT. Race staff, guests, & crew (all participants) must sign for their own passes and must arrive while registration is open. Race staff license and membership card must be presented at registration. DRIVERS ARE LIMITED TO 5 CREW MEMBERS, including the ENTRANT, for a TOTAL COUNT OF SIX PEOPLE PER CAR FOR THE ENTIRE EVENT WEEKEND. NO EXCEPTIONS!! ALL CREW MEMBERS MUST BE LISTED ON THE DRIVER'S ENTRY FORM TO GAIN ADMISSION. NO EXCEPTIONS! ALL WORKERS ARE REQUIRED TO REGISTER ONLINE.

PIT LANE: The speed limit on pit lane is 40 MPH. Violators may be penalized

REGIONAL CLASSES:, R1, R2, ITEZ, and GTT shall be permitted to participate in accordance with the Regional class rules in the Supplementary Regulations for Sanction Number 20-R-XXXX. Divisional classes as published on the web at www.SEDIVRacing.com will be permitted to participate.

EMERGENCY CALLS: CFR has an emergency number at the track (863) 655-3033. In case of emergency and you cannot reach this number, call the Highlands County Sheriff Office at (863) 385-5111. Inform the Sheriff's office that the party you need to get in touch with is at Sebring International Raceway.

PARKING/PADDOCK RULES: Failure to follow the direction of the Paddock Marshal or CFR Race Officials regarding paddock parking or activities may result in expulsion from the facility. Do not park parallel to major infield roads. No Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) of any type may be employed by Participants/Guests at CFR events without specific SCCA and FAA approval.

RADIO FREQUENCIES: CFR operates on frequencies 464.525, 464.975, 464.675, 464.825, 464.0125, and 469.0125. These frequencies are guarded and not to be used by any competitor or visitor. CFR communications are rebroadcast on analog frequencies 464.6750 (primary) and 469.6750 (Secondary). Teams are encouraged to monitor Race Control.

PROVISIONS: Camping is allowed in the paddock on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights. Water and electricity are available in limited areas of the paddock. Fuel will be available at the track. <u>Tires</u>: for GOODYEAR, contact <u>Sasco Sports</u> at (434) 822-7200; HOOSIER, contact APPALACHIAN RACE TIRES, (865) 681-6622. Do not leave used tires at track! For <u>safety equipment and racing products</u> call Trackside Tim's for race and safety equipment, (803) 446-3995, or Wine Country Motorsports.

GENERAL RULES. ATV's are permitted in certain areas provided they are used in a safe manner and operated ONLY by licensed drivers. Bicycles may be used only by race officials and responsible adults. Skateboards, skates, rollerblades, micro/mini racers, go-peds and motorized scooters are NOT permitted. No person will be admitted into the raceway without the proper credentials. Absolutely NO bedding new brakes or testing of cars on infield roadways will be permitted. Violations will result in immediate ejection from the premises. This penalty will be enacted for all offenses, with zero tolerance. You must leave the premises no later than 3 hours after the last checker drops on Sunday.


TECH: A CFR issued tech sticker will be issued for the practice day, bring the appropriate gear with you to tech as required for a race event.

INSURANCE: Participant insurance will be provided in at least the minimum amounts required by the SCCA.

COURSE RESTRICTIONS: Only official vehicles will be allowed on the course before and after racing activities.

COURSE: This event will be held on the Sebring International Raceway Modified "School" Course which is a 2.0-mile road course. Pit and paddock will be located in the 12-hour paddock. See the track map at the end of these Supplementary Regulations. Absolutely no unauthorized access to the course after hours will be permitted. Drivers failing to negotiate Turn 15 must slow before entering Turn 16 as to not gain advantage. Failure to do so may result in a penalty from the Operating Steward. For all races, cars will be split immediately upon entering the course from the false grid. Be Alert!
