Car Requirements

- Race cars (caged) will need all proper safety equipment. NO expired equipment - Please see the Tech Inspector if you are planning on racing a caged car.
- All vehicles need to be complete i.e. doors, hatches, bumpers etc.
- Cars without glass require window nets and full-face helmets.
- All loose items must be removed prior to track entry i.e. floormats etc.

- Vehicle must be dimensionally wider than tall.

Safety Inspection

- All cars must pass Safety Inspection before admittance to the track.
- All drivers must present personal safety equipment to the Tech Inspector.
- It is the responsibility of the competitor to fill out the Tech Inspection Sheet at or prior to registration.
- SA2015 Helmet or newer & OEM 3-point harness in good condition are the minimum required safety equipment.

No trophy or checkered flag is worth more than friendship or injury. No professional talent scouts are lurking in our midst, so keep it safe. Remember **Seat Time** is the path to expanding the limit of car and driver.

Rules of the DirtX Event Venue

- Every entrant shall sign the waiver at the gate or Registration.
- Any person may be requested to provide proof of membership in an ASN Canada affiliated club. If wristbands or other identification are issued at the gate, such ID will be considered acceptable proof of compliance.
- Any offensive, defamatory or vulgar messages must be completely removed or masked over prior to arrival.
- An entrant is responsible at all times for all guests and crew.
- All non racetrack areas have a STRICT speed limit of 10 Km/h
- Only registered competition vehicles will be allowed paddock space.
- Any vehicle which utilizes a lithium-based battery system is forbidden from driving on the track surface at any time.
- Location will be first come, first served. Sharing of pits is permitted (canopies, etc)
- No vehicles or equipment will extend past the gate area.
- There will be no parking along the fence.
- No individual shall cross the racing surface without authorization from a track official during the schedule of events.
- No mind-altering substances permitted until the checkered flag flies on the last race of the day. (Alcoholic, Cannabinoid, or otherwise)
- All pets must be kept on leash AT ALL TIMES.
- Children 12 and under are not allowed inside the paddock area unless accompanied by an adult.
- Motorized pit vehicles are to be operated by licensed drivers only and must carry their car number so staff can identify the owner when they need to be moved.

Clean Up:

The venue is a private residence and as such, WSCC and its members are responsible for ALL clean up and repairs at each event (pack out what you pack in. No garbage facilities will be provided).

A \$50 clean-up fee and/or refusal of subsequent entry WILL be applied to competitors leaving the pits in other than clean condition.

Infractions may result in ejection from the facility without recourse at the discretion of the Race Officials.
