| <input type="checkbox"/> Wheels: not cracked or bent, hubcaps and beauty rings removed, lug nuts present and torqued | <input type="checkbox"/> Body & Glass: no cracks or excessive windshield pitting, at least 2 rear view mirrors present, secure and clear, doors, windows, hood and trunk lids operable and secure. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Brakes: pedal firm, brake fluid fresh, pads 5mm minimum thickness, hoses sound, rotors no cracks, deep scoring, or wear beyond specifications | <input type="checkbox"/> Battery & Electrical: solidly mounted with positive terminal covered, no bare wires |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Seat and Seatbelts: properly mounted, secure, and in good condition. 3-point OEM belts or FIA/SFI/FHTSA labeled harnesses (4-pt must be ASM. Passenger belts must be equal to or better than Driver's belts | <input type="checkbox"/> Fluids: (oil, fuel, coolant, steering, brake, clutch, shocks) NO LEAKS, fresh, at proper level, catch container(s) on vented systems (e.g, radiator overflow) |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Steering: no excess play, no unusual noises | <input type="checkbox"/> Fire Extinguisher: securely mounted if present. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Throttle: has quick, positive return | <input type="checkbox"/> Roll Bar: convertibles and open cars must have a four point (minimum) "broomstick rule" roll bar |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Lights: brake lights and turn signals all work | <input type="checkbox"/> Other: inspect all other items which are appropriate for your vehicle |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Suspension: No free play in bearings and ball joints, no unusual noises, suspension mounts secure | |

Your Personal Safety Equipment

- ☐ Helmet: Rated Snell SA2005, M2005 or later (Starting January 2016: 2010 or later)
- ☐ Clothing: Long sleeve shirt and full length pants, natural or fire resistant fibers (cotton, wool, Nomex, CarbonX, etc.)
- ☐ Shoes: Comfortable closed shoes with narrow, flexible non-slip sole (no boots, sandals, clogs, slippers, etc.)
- ☐ Driving Gloves: (recommended)
- ☐ Eye Protection: Eye glasses, sun glasses (recommended) or full face helmet with face shield (required in open cars)
- ☐ Head & Neck Restraints: SFI/FIA-rated head and neck support (recommended if approved harnesses are installed)
- ☐ Open Cars: Full face helmet with face shield required. Arm restraints for both driver and passenger (recommended)
