



**Tour de North Rally
26 April 2026
Supplementary Regulations**

General Announcement

The Rally Association of Vancouver Island (RAVI) will promote a Time/Speed/Distance Navigational rally on Saturday 26 April 2026. The event will predominantly run on paved surface, with approx 400m on smooth gravel. Total distance will be approximately 166 km.

Jurisdiction

The rally is sanctioned by Rally Pacific Motorsports (RPM, the BC region of CARS), and follows the current BC Rally Regulations, which are posted here:

and C.A.R.S. General Competition Rules.

This is round #1 of our club series of 2 novice events for 2026.

Required Equipment:

One (1) self supporting reflective warning triangle (30cm per side), some will be available to borrow, but please bring your own if you have one.

Either a spare tire, or the factory equipped alternative. Jack and wrench.

Additional lights on the front should meet legal requirements as to type and mounting height, and must be wired to the high beam lights such that the additional lights turn off when switching to low beam. Fog lights may be wired independently.

All vehicles must be in compliance with all Provincial regulations for roadworthiness including the requirement for seat belts. See tech check sheet for what will be included in technical inspection - download from MSR registration.

All vehicles will require a smart phone with the Richta Competitor App (<https://richtarally.com/>) loaded **and ready to activate** at the start. For best results, all other apps should be closed. Please place the device in the vehicle so that it always has a clear view of the sky. The Richta scoring system requires this app to be running. For your own benefit it is recommended you bring:
Writing implements, note pad, calculator, drink and snacks.

A First Aid Kit (contents as per CARS) and Fire Extinguisher is recommended. For this event, due to continuous cell reception and the event taking place on well travelled paved roads, the First Aid Kit and Fire Extinguisher requirement is waived.

Entry, Fees and Costs

Registration will only be via MotorsportReg.com and includes payment. All involved, including competitors, and volunteers, are required to sign the required waiver(s) using the Motorsportreg waiver system, preferably immediately after registration on MSR, but for sure prior to arriving at the event.

Entry fee: \$80 per car (driver and navigator required).

\$5 discount for any RPM affiliated club member ie RAVI, WCRA, IRSA, SBRCC etc.

Maximum number of entries: 30

Car numbers will be assigned at the discretion of the Rallymaster, with lower numbers assigned to experienced teams.

Event officials reserve the right to reject any entry without recourse. An entry may be withdrawn: (a) without penalty, up to 48 hours before the start of registration; (b) with up to 25% of the entry fee in penalty, less than 48 hours before the start of registration (percentage at organizer's discretion); (c) with up to 100% of the entry fee in penalty after the opening of registration (percentage at the organizer's discretion)

Changes for 2026

Note that we will be making the following changes from previous years:

Novice orientation will be held prior to the event by zoom. Two sessions scheduled.

Tech Inspection and Routebook preparation will be held in parallel.

Starting 09:00 the driver will have approx 1 hr to get the tech done and on completion must affix the car decal.

Starting 09:00 the navigator will have approx 1hr to enter the rally into Rabbit.
