TECH:

All drag racers will need to run through a quick tech inspection before running. Tech will be located in Garage #21 and will be open for drag racing tech inspections from 2pm – 4pm on both Friday and Saturday.

PRE-RACE TECH INSPECTION CHECK LIST

- Operational tail light required/brake light recommended.
- Operational front and rear brakes required on all machines.
- Rear fender must be full width
- Cannot be pushed or pulled to start.
- No hand shifted motorcycles.
- Self-returning (snap back) throttle
- Valid state issued driver's license and be 18 years of age or older.
- Street legal DOT Tires in good condition required (Bare cords not permitted) Racing Slicks OK
- Motorcycle jacket, closed back full finger gloves and boots or shoes (above ankles) mandatory all bikes
- All riders must have DOT rated full-face or ¾ style helmets
- Bikes must be in good condition – no oil leaks or loose parts

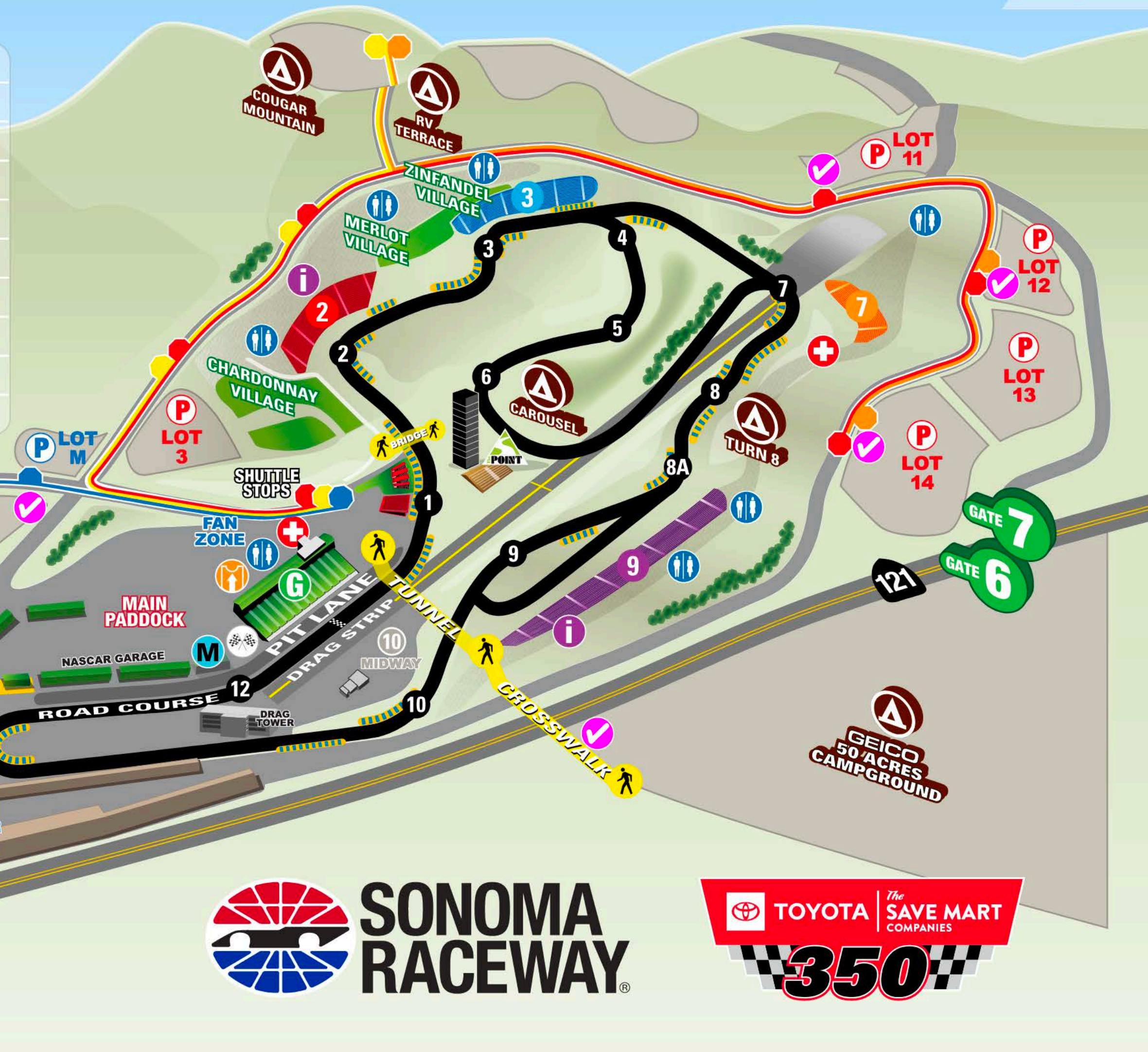
