

2023 Technical Inspection and Equipment Checklist

Body

- Functional brake lights
- Hood, doors, trunk and body panels secured
- Windshield has no major cracks. Windows must be all the way up or all the way down.
- □ Gas cap intact and tightened
- Numbers clearly affixed on both sides of vehicle

Interior

- Seats well secured
- Seat belts required in good working order and condition
- All loose items (including floor mats) removed from cockpit, glove box, console, trunk, etc.
- Pedals have free return and in good operating condition, firm brake pedal

Suspension

- □ Wheel bearings properly adjusted, no play
- No excessive suspension deflection between Min and Max
- No excessive steering play
- No frayed or leaking hydraulic brake, steering, or clutch lines
- □ 50% or greater remaining brake lining/pad required
- Shock absorbers in good working order

Engine and Drivetrain

- □ No fluid leaks of any kind (gas, oil or coolant)
- Battery properly secured (NO Bungees)
- All hoses, oil, fuel, and water, with no visible signs of damage. Securely clamped/tightened
- Exhaust system securely attached
- □ Throttle return is safe and positive
- Radiator secure, proper overflow container

Exhaust

98 db rule strictly enforced. One chance for repair/modification. If it fails, vehicle will be disqualified.

Wheels and Tires

- □ Tires properly inflated and defect free
- Street tires 2/32" average tread depth, no cord visible. Competition tires (slicks) allowed
- All lug nuts/knockoffs torqued to spec, hubcaps, trim rings, center caps, removed
- No visible cracks in wheels

Driver Equipment

- Helmet must be M/SA/K 2010 or newer. DOT only not allowed
- Goggles/face shields (eye protection) for open cars
- Proper footwear, no sandals or opened toe shoe
