_____	_____	Seat Belts	No frayed seat belts. 5 or 6 point belts must have racing seat, <u>head & neck restraint</u> and seat belt date of mfg. in last 5 years
_____	_____	Shoes	No sandals or flipflops, no open toe shoes
_____	_____	Brake Lights	Functioning properly
_____	_____	Battery	Securely held down
_____	_____	Tires	No cord, no cracks in side walls
_____	_____	Helmet	Must have a Snell 2010 or later SA or M or K rating sticker inside the helmet or loaner.
