Rental Kart league Rules & Regulations

We will not be accepting walk-ins for this league season. You must pre-register through Motorsports Reg.

Race Dates:

Refer to Motorsportreg.com event for specific dates.

Information:

Looking for some competition? Come join us for our Rental Kart Leagues. These leagues allow 16+ year old drivers the chance to win great prizes and compete with like minded and similarly skilled drivers on the most extreme kart racing track in the world.

Registration:

You can register for the entire season or for each race when you arrive.

The event schedule will be as follows:

6:30 P.M. Check-In Cut-off

6:45 P.M. - 7:00 P.M. Drivers Meeting (Mandatory)

7:00 P.M. - 9:00 P.M. Driving Sessions

Each Driver will have a Practice Session, Qualifying Session, and 1, 12-Lap Heat Race.

We will combine/split classes as deemed necessary depending on entries per class.

9:15 P.M. Podium Ceremonies

Paid Practice:

League drivers will be allowed to run practice sessions at a discount on the day of the event.

Drivers' Meeting:

All entrants must be present at the drivers' meeting. Random roll call will be taken and if a driver is absent during roll call he/she will start race 1 at the back of the grid no matter what your qualifying time states.

Qualifying:

Qualifying is a six-minute session in which the fastest lap for each driver will order the grid for the start of the race. The Kart you are assigned during qualifying is the kart you start the race in.

Race Start:

The start of the race will be a standing start. The grid will be ordered based on the overall fastest lap times from qualifying with the divisions separated. This may vary depending on Race Director Preference.

Timing & Scoring:

Your times will be posted on the TV's in the retail space and results will be posted on our facebook page and on the speed screens each Wednesday night

****Serving Black Flag****

When a driver has received a black flag, that driver will enter the pit lane for a stop-and-go penalty.

Weight Divisions (Limited Ballast Available for Use):

Light Class (135+)

Medium Class (175+ lbs)

Heavy Class (215+ lbs)

Each driver must meet or exceed the minimum weight for their team's class at the scales following each on-track session.

Kart Failures:

****Kart Failure by User Error****In the event of a kart failure on track due to a driver being too aggressive or not listening to corner marshals. He/she will be assessed penalties and or removed from the event for the remainder of the season without any refunds.

Equipment:

****Lead Ballast****Lead ballast is provided at no charge for driver usage. Please note there is a limited amount of lead to be shared between all drivers. Plan accordingly.

However, if a driver fails to properly secure a piece of ballast and it becomes damaged by flying off of the go kart, the team captain may be charged a replacement lead fee.

Penalties:

Underweight → DQ

Aggressive Driving → Minimum of 3 positions, potential DQ

Bump Drafting in Qualifying → Loss of fastest lap for each offense
