

COVID-19 UPDATE

- 1. All Drivers and Volunteers must register on-line at MotorsportReg.com prior to the event.
- 2. All Participants must complete an Adult Annual Waiver and submit the notarized waiver to the National Office Prior to the event.
- 3. All SCCA Membership/License Cards must have an identifiable and accurate photo of Member.
- 4. All Crew members' names and SCCA membership numbers must be submitted to the Chief Registrar.
- 5. A Driver Packet will be e-mailed to all registered drivers prior to the event. You must bring your completed packet emailed from Chief Registrar after submitting information listed above or you will not be permitted to participate.
- 6. Grid and Race Results will be posted outside on windows of MSR Clubhouse. Paper copies will not be provided. A QR Code will be posted so you can access results online. QR Scanners are available through your phone's app store. All results will be available after the event on the Southwest Division website.
- 7. Lunches will be provided to all SCCA workers. There will be no after race party on Saturday.

DRIVER'S SCHOOL STUDENTS

- 1. School Students will be required to apply for a Novice Permit from the SCCA National Office and have in hand prior to the Event
- 2. School Students will be required to complete an on-line SCCA Training prior to the Event.
- 3. School Students will receive more detailed information after registering online.

I. GENERAL

Everyone entering the MSRC Paddock gate will be required to sign a waiver, show proof of SCCA membership and annual waiver and sign an MSRH Track waiver, upon entrance. Wristbands will be issued and must be worn or attached to the SCCA ID for the duration of the event.

- A. This event will be held under the 2020 General Competition Rules and all changes published in FASTRACK.
- B. Participant Accident Insurance is provided as in the SCCA Master Plan.
- C. The organizers reserve the right to postpone, abandon, or cancel the event or any part of the event. Entry fees will be refunded to those offered no opportunity to compete.
- D. Each car must be fitted with a working AMB compatible timing transponder for the entire event, Saturday, and Sunday.

II FNTRIES

- A. An entry is not considered complete until the proper fee, as listed on the Official Entry Form, is received.
- B. Online Registration will close at 11:59pm, Wednesday, September 16, 2020
- C. Competitor who do not have all required credentials in their possession thereby requiring a call to the National Office to confirm eligibility should make arrangements with the Registrar by 11:59pm, September 16, 2020
- D. Competitors who need to resolve license issues contact SOWDIV Licensing DA Moses Smith 817.382.4188 sowdivlicensing@gmail.com
- E. REFUNDS will be available to drivers who are verified as not having turned a wheel on the track ONLY if the Registrar is notified during registration hours. In order to receive a refund, you must inform the Registrar of your cancellation. It is up to the Chief Registrar to issue the refund per their discretion.
- F. SOWDIV permanent numbers will be honored for all entries received by Monday September 14, 2020. Duplicates resolved on a first come basis.

- G. Texas Region reserves the right to reject any entry, and to modify the Schedule of Events depending on the number of entries received as provided for in the GCR. The final schedule for this event will not be set until 5pm Friday September 19, 2020. The official schedule will be posted online at MotorsportsReg.com, as well as at registration Friday night.
- H. Only drivers who hold an SCCA Full Competition License, SCCA Regional License, SCCA Novice Permit, or have been signed off on Saturday School, or an SCCA Pro License are eligible to enter. (per GCR 3.1.1.B)

III. REGISTRATION

- A. Prior to SCCA Registration Everyone arriving at the track must sign Track Waiver at the MSRC Gate or Clubhouse or during SCCA registration beginning at 7:00AM Saturday, September 19, 2020.
- B. Wrist Bands will be issued to All Drivers and Crew and must be worn to be admitted to the race track and hot pits.
- C. The Registrar will not issue crew passes to non-SCCA members. Weekend memberships are available for \$15. These crew members must be listed on the registration entry in order to gain free entrance to the track.

IV. CAR SAFETY and TECH INSPECTION

- A. No smoking or engines running in Tech garage.
- B. Before presentation at Tech, all items on the tech card must be filled out down through "official weight" and "wheelbase" and the event page in the vehicle logbook must be filled out.
- C. Tech will keep the Vehicle Log Book for any car presented with no tech sheet from registration until that sheet is furnished.
- D. Sound control readings will be posted in Tech. The maximum sound limit allowable is 103dB.
- E. Any car involved in an accident or metal to metal contact with another car, of if so directed by a race official, must report to Tech at the end of that session. (SEE VI Below)
- F. Lost and found is at Tech.
- G. Road Racing Sound will be conducted consistent with the GCR. Readings will be posted at Tech.

V. IMPOUND

- A. The Chief Steward will be available in Tech at the conclusion of each Sunday Qualifying Session, for questions or clarifications, as well there will be a written driver's letter, in lieu of a Drivers' meeting. It is not mandatory for drivers to report to impound or meet with the Chief Steward after the Saturday Qualifying session unless directed to do so by the Black Flag Steward or other official.
- B. Drivers may request a Split Start after the Saturday Qualifying Session. The Chief Steward will approve a Split Start only if the majority of drivers in a session are in favor.
- C. The top three finishers in each class must report to IMPOUND at the end of each Race for post race inspection per the pre-approved tech plan.

VI. CONTACT

VII.

- A. If a Driver is involved in significant body contact, the driver and car shall stop at the designated incident investigate site for review of the incident by the stewards before going go their paddock area.
- B. The designated incident investigation site is the Black Flag Station.
- C. "Significant body contact" includes but is not limited to: contact resulting in 2 or 4 wheels off course, spins, loss of position, or repairs to suspension or bodywork
- D. If a driver instructed to report to the Chief Steward fails to do so, they may be penalized, including loss of qualifying position.
- E. Further action toward a driver will be under the provisions of the 2020 GCR, 2020 Penalty Guidelines, and these Supplemental Regulations.

VIII. PARKING

- A. Parking will be at a premium. All guests and visitors may be required to park outside the gate to the paddock as paddock parking may be limited to one paddock vehicle per racer.
- B. Open trailers may be required to park outside of the paddock area.
- C. Please inform all drivers, crew and guests that they must follow the Course Marshall's instructions.
- D. Please observe marked NO Parking areas in the paddock at MSR Cresson. Members and businesses will need access to their private garages. DO NOT BLOCK GARAGE DRIVEWAYS OR DOORS.

IX. FACILITY RULES

- A. Please be courteous and use good judgement when parking your trailers and support vehicles.
- B. Paddocks must maintain a clear lane at all times for fire and emergency equipment as well as race traffic.
- C. Please keep paddock area clean by using the trash containers.
- D. Maximum speed limit in the paddock is 10 mph.
- E. No fluids may be drained onto pavement or ground. Please use MSR provided disposal containers for oil and coolants. Oil dry must be applied IMMEDIATELY to clean up accidental spills.
- F. Driving stakes into the asphalt is prohibited.
- G. No motorized vehicle may be driven except by a licensed driver. Imprudent operation will be penalized.
- H. Skateboards, rollerblades, and roller skates are not allowed per MSR Track Rules
- I. No Loud Music or Engines after 9:00pm
- J. NO PETS ALLOWED per MSR Track Rules
- K. No parking between and or around garages. Please allow access lanes to all garages and DO NOT BLOCK GARAGE DRIVEWAYS AND DOORS.
- L. Do not dispose of used batteries at the track. Take them with you.
- M. MSR Members and their Guests and their vehicles will be admitted to the Paddock and Garages upon signing the Track Waiver.

X. OTHER

- A. The Race Chairman, Chief Steward, Stewards of the Meet, and other race officials will normally be located in the Club House.
- B. Novice Permit drivers must display a prominent "X" on the back and on both sides of their race cars.

- C. Competitors who have mechanical problems and need to test their race car at speed may be allowed a hardship lap at the discretion of the Chief Steward.
- D. Grids, results, and trophies will be available at Driver Information.
- E. F&C communications may be monitored on frequency 151.625. Please DO NOT use these for team communications.

XI. OTHER PROVISIONS

- A. The Chief Steward and Stewards of the Meet reserve the right to combine or split race groups and to modify the schedule and/or length of sessions as may be required.
- B. A Checkered Flag may be displayed at the Black Flag station to indicate the end of a practice or qualifying session. During practice, drivers must proceed directly to the pits. During Races drivers may opt to run a cool down lap after being shown the checkered Flag.
- C. Flag Station 7 will Start and Flag the Race from the back straight. The Checkered Flag will be thrown from Flag Station 1 at the end of the front straight before Turn 1.
