

Peterson Museum Tour

California-Inland Region will meet at Margarita's Mexican Grill in Santa Clarita on Saturday, February 20, 2016 for breakfast. After breakfast, we will drive to the newly remodeled Peterson Automotive Museum for a tour of their excellent facility. Although there will be a few of Porsche's finest on display, the museum has a little bit of everything. You can expect to see significant older cars, hot rods, concept cars, race cars and classics. Many of the cars are set up in dioramas to show what they might look like in their time period or natural habitat and there are over 300 cars on display. The self-guided tour should take no more than two hours and there is a cafe available if you get hungry or thirsty. Photography is permitted with hand-held cameras only, no tripods or mono-pods. The facility has over 100,000 square feet of display space and there is a little of something automotive for everyone.

We will meet in Palmdale at the Albertson's Market at Tierra Subida Ave. and Elizabeth Lake Road at 8:15 a.m. and then leave for Margarita's at 8:30 for breakfast at 9:30.
