Close of Entries: Wednesday, September 18, 2024, or as extended by registration officials.

DRIVER ELIGIBILITY:

Drivers should review the criteria at <https://www.scca.com/pages/race-experience-driver-eligibility> to be sure they meet the requirements.

VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY:

This event is open to production-based cars and small-bore GT cars meeting SCCA Road Race safety requirements found at <https://www.scca.com/pages/race-experience-vehicle-requirements>. Purpose built racecars like Formula Cars, Sports Racers, Bog Bore GT Cars and Pro Series cars are not appropriate for this event. If you have questions about your specific car, please contact the registrar and your question will be sent to the appropriate party.

ENTRY FEES:

- Endurance Race Entry (per car) \$ 500.00

Endurance Entry Fee is per car/team (maximum 4 drivers per team, minimum 1 driver change.) Only SCCA members will be issued crew credentials (weekend members are eligible.) Non-members will receive visitor/guest passes but may not enter hazardous (hot) areas. Members and non-members must always wear their credentials/passes visibly. Credentials are valid only for the person to whom they were issued. Credential fraud of any kind will result in a penalty to anyone involved.

REGISTRATION:

Registration for this event can be accessed via this link on motorsportreg.com/FallFrolicEnduro. If you have not previously registered for one of our events via the Online Registration System you will be prompted to create an account to register. When registering, please verify that your medical history, car information, email, and cell phone are still accurate. In addition, your SCCA annual membership or weekend membership must be current and valid. Acceptable payment includes Visa, MC, Discover, Check, or PayPal. If you need help registering, please contact the race chair or the registrar.

- Online registration will close at midnight of the Wednesday prior to the event, unless extended by registration officials.
- Event payments will be processed at the time of check-in at track. After registration closes, changes may incur a late fee. A \$50.00 fee will be assessed on returned checks.
- Registration check-in will be held in Registration/Hospitality, located upstairs in the concession building. All drivers, volunteers and officials must check-in to complete registration and receive credentials, even if you have signed an annual SCCA waiver.
- Cancellations shall be made through the Chief Registrar prior to the event. Refund requests after the event is complete, must be made to the region treasurer teri.massey@comcast.net within 7 calendar days following the event.
- Refunds due to mechanical failure will be considered by the Chief Registrar for cars that have not been on the racing surface as verified by the Chief of T & S. Requests must be submitted to the Chief Registrar before the end of the event.
- Approved refunds will be issued via Motorsportreg.
- Only members who hold a current SCCA membership may be credentialed for the hot areas. Weekend memberships can be purchased at registration, during posted hours, for a fee of \$15.00.

TECH:

Tech inspection hours are posted on the event schedule.

Before being allowed to go on track, each vehicle must go through a Safety Inspection. Vehicles with a current SCCA Annual Tech Inspection in their logbooks will be honored. Cars without an annual tech sticker will need to visit tech to be individually inspected. It is highly recommended that this be done early Saturday morning.

REQUIRED DRIVER EQUIPMENT:

This event requires drivers to wear a driver's suit, helmet, gloves, shoes and a head & neck restraint device that meets specific requirements. Those full requirements can be found here: <https://www.scca.com/pages/race-experience=driver-safety-gear>.

SCALES:

Scales will be available from 8:00am until the beginning of competition. Driving on or off the scales is prohibited unless otherwise instructed by Tech personnel. Motors must be turned off and competitors and/or crew must push cars on and off scales.

CLASSING:

For this initial Race Experience Enduro, there will be no classing.

EVENT FORMAT:

Other than the exceptions below, the procedures for competition, pit stops and event rules will follow the SCCA Race Experience Rules which can be found on page 32 of this document: [Race Experience Rules](#)

EXCEPTIONS TO RACE EXPERIENCE SPORTING REGULATIONS:

The driver must be out of the car, the engine must be off, and no other work may be done to the car during refueling.

STARTING LINEUP/GRID:

The Race Grid will be determined by lap times from the Saturday practice/qualifying session. Teams that do not make that session, or a driver starting the race who didn't get to practice during that session, will start at the back.

- A. Crew / Guests must leave the grid at the one-minute warning.
- B. The speed limit in the hot pit lane is 25 MPH. Drivers may not scrub tires in Pit Lane or in the paddock.

TIMING AND SCORING:

All cars are required to use fully operational **MyLaps (formerly AMB)** transponders, and the driver is responsible for providing correct information during registration. Unless otherwise announced, live timing will be available via the Race Monitor and Speedhive App.

- A. Non-operational transponders or missing transponder information may not be scored for the event.
 - a. A limited number of transponders may be available for rent at the rate of \$30.00 per day, along with a \$500 retainer on a valid credit card.
 - b. A competitor needing a rental unit should make those arrangements at the time of entry submission.
- B. The clock will continue to run during all flag conditions, except for the red flag.
- C. Personal timing beacons are not allowed within 20 feet on either side of the T & S system at Start/Finish, or across track from S/F.

RESULTS:

Qualifying and final results will be posted at Registration / Hospitality. Additionally, final results will be posted to the Colorado Region website no later than 7 days following the completion of the event.

AWARDS:

Trophies for the Enduro will be awarded at the event.

FLAGGING:

- A. Signaling will be done with flags.
- B. BLACK FLAG station is at corner station 8.
- C. Individual black flags and mechanical black flags, as well as sound and transponder boards with the car number, will be shown at both Start/Finish and corner 8.
- D. For practice sessions, a CHECKERED FLAG signaling the end of the session may be displayed at BOTH Start/Finish AND Corner 8. Cars receiving the checkered flag at Corner 8 must proceed directly to the pit lane/paddock.
- E. Last lap will be indicated by a waving white flag at start/finish. The checkered flag will only be displayed at Start/Finish.

DISABLED CARS:

Disabled or damaged cars may be removed from the course and delivered to a central location. If the car has sustained body/chassis damage it will be taken to impound and will be released to the driver/crew after tech has made appropriate notations in the vehicle log book. Cars disabled due to a mechanical failure will be released to the driver/crew immediately. If the car requires wrecker support to return to its paddock location, there may be a delay depending on the availability of wreckers or flat tows.

SOUND CONTROL:

A maximum of 103dB is in effect for this event. Sound will be located at turn 8 and readings will be posted at Hospitality.

RADIO FREQUENCIES:

The region frequencies below shall not be used for communications by any participant.

PADDOCK:

- A. Access ways for general paddock traffic and emergency vehicles must be kept clear at all times or vehicles will be towed.
- B. You must have a valid motor vehicle license to operate any 2, 3, or 4-wheeled motorized or non-motorized vehicles in the paddock.
- C. Skateboards, skates, rollerblades, and one-wheel electric boards are prohibited.
- D. The paddock speed limit is 10 M.P.H. Vehicles in the paddock must be operated in a safe manner.
- E. Entrants are responsible for the conduct of their crew, guests, minors, and pets. All minors must be under direct adult supervision at all times. Pets in the paddock must be leashed and under direct supervision of an adult at all times.
- F. Minors and non-members must remain behind any barrier paralleling the hot pit lane. No one will be allowed to view from in front of the race control and timing structure.

TRACK TOURS:

Track walks will be available Friday night after open lapping when the track is cold. And again on Saturday morning between 6 AM and 7 AM.

GENERAL:

- A. **The gate to enter and exit the track facility cannot be opened when the track is hot. Please plan accordingly.**
- B. The organizers reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the event, or any part of the event. Entry fees will be refunded to those offered no opportunity to compete.
- C. Any test day or session not on the official schedule is NOT sanctioned by SCCA and is NOT covered by SCCA Insurance.
- D. Vendors wishing to display or sell any items must obtain prior approval from the race chair.
- E. The consumption of alcohol is prohibited until after the daily on track activities are concluded. In addition, GCR 2.3.1.B shall be in effect as it relates to Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs.
- F. The organizers reserve the right to refuse entry and/or issuance of credentials to the premises or event for any reason except race, color, creed, sex, or national origin.
- G. Unmanned aerial vehicles, also known as drones, shall not be used anywhere in the airspace over the property.
- H. All on track body contact (including contact during drafting) that causes a car to act erratically and results in a change of position or a car leaving the course will be investigated.
