ROEBLING ROAD RACEWAY, SAVANNAH, GA

Welcome to Roebling Road Raceway and to Buccaneer Region's Drivers School and to SARRC racing in 2025. For those of you racing Sunday, it will be a great opportunity to begin accumulating points early towards the 2025 South Atlantic Road Racing Championship.

Registration at the track will open at 3:00 pm on Thursday, February 20th for the Drivers School and for Tech inspection.

For the Drivers School students please keep in mind the most important thing is for you to get track time. Therefore, make sure your car is prepared prior to leaving home and please bring crew with you to assist with your race car while you are in the classroom or with your instructor.

Additionally for Drivers School students, please remember to complete the on-line Drivers School training and test before arriving at the track.

For the SARRC drivers, Sunday's races may be your and others first outing this season. Therefore, please be respectful of your fellow drivers, especially those new drivers who just completed their drivers school on Saturday. We want everyone to have plenty of green flag laps of racing and be able to drive their cars back on the trailer Sunday afternoon for the return home.

Before arriving, please look at and be familiar with Appendix "P" Racing Room & Passing Guidelines. This is found in your GCR. This is an important addition to the GCR created by drivers for drivers and officials to use as a guide for on track behavior and incidents.

Please remember GCR 6.11.1 "Rules of the Road" and if involved in a metal-to-metal incident on track during a session it is your responsibility to report to the Chief Steward or the Operating Steward in Tech at the end of the session.

Cameras, GCR 9.3.11 require all cars to have a forward-facing camera that is recording at all times while on track and video must be provided when requested by race officials. Failure to provide such video may result in penalties.

Qualifying and Race Results will be posted on the Bulletin Board at the end of the covered garages.

Watch for announcements via the track's PA or by email blast through MSR for any schedule changes that may be required during the weekend.

There will be an in-person Drivers Meeting held at approximately 12:00 noon on Saturday in the Classroom in the maintenance shed near turn 4. Please attend this meeting.

There will be a social Saturday evening at the conclusion of on track activities at the Concession building. There will be food and beverages provided. You, your crew, family and friends are encouraged to attend. This is a great opportunity congratulate our newest drivers, but also to thank all our volunteer workers. They are some of your biggest fans.

Please be mindful of the track's neighbors and observe the speed limit as you come and go from the track.

In closing, if you have any questions during the weekend I will be located in or around the Tech area most of the weekend.

Again, we are glad you have chosen to attend Buccaneer Region's Drivers School and the Southeast Divisions SARRC Series race. Please stay safe and have fun both on and off the track this weekend.
