2022 HYLER CRAFT MEMORIAL DRIVERS SCHOOL AND SARRC RACE
FEBRUARY 25-27, 2022
ROEBLING ROAD RACEWAY

We welcome you to Roebling Road Raceway and to Buccaneer Region's Drivers School and to the first SARRC race in 2022. For those of you racing Sunday it will be a great opportunity to begin accumulating points early toward the 2022 South Atlantic Road Racing Championship.

First, COVID is still with us so while on site please follow all facility and SCCA protocols and guidelines. Be respectful of all those around you.

The gates will open at noon on Thursday February 24th for Drivers School registration and Tech Inspection.

For the Drivers School students please keep in mind the most important thing is for you to get track time. Therefore, make sure your car is prepared prior to leaving home and please bring crew or someone with you to assist with your race car while you are in the classroom or with your instructor.

For the SARRC drivers, for Sunday's race this may be your or others first outing this season. Therefore, please be respectful of your fellow drivers, especially those new drivers who just completed their driver's school on Saturday. Leave a little extra room on a pass. We want everyone to have plenty of green flag laps of racing and to be able to drive their car back on the trailer Sunday afternoon.

Before arriving, please look at Appendix P "Racing Room & Passing Guidelines" in your GCR. This is an important recent addition created by drivers for drivers and officials to use as a guide for on track incidents.

Please also remember GCR 6.11.1 "Rules of the Road" and if involved in a metal-to-metal incident on track during a session it is your responsibility to report to the Chief Steward or the Operating Steward at the end of the session.

Impound. Reminder that following all races Sunday the top 3 cars in each class will be required to report to impound.

Qualifying and Race Results will be posted on the Bulletin Board near the covered garages. All sessions will be timed and available via Race Hero or Race Monitor.

Watch for announcements via the track's PA or by email blast through MSR for any schedule changes that may be required during the weekend.

There may be an in-person Drivers Meeting held during lunch on Saturday. If so, it will be announced via email blast.

There will be a social Saturday evening. You and your crew, family and friends are encouraged to attend. It will be a great time to not only celebrate and congratulate our newest drivers, but to also take the opportunity thank all our volunteer workers.

In closing, please be mindful of the track's neighbors and observe the speed limit as you come and go from the track.

If you have any questions I will be located in or around the Tech area most of the weekend.

Again, we are glad you have chosen to attend the Buccaneer Region's Drivers School and the Southeast Division's SARRC Series race. Please stay safe and have fun both on and off the track this weekend.
