- Open Wheel; Formula Jr, Formula Vee, Quantum Formula-S, Formula 3, Formula Ford.
- Racing Exhibition: Open track, limited passing non-race format. Open to eligible cars whose drivers may not wish to drive in a competitive race environment. Also, select cars that may not qualify in the above categories but are deemed appropriate by the event organizers; by application.
