- _____ Brake pads, fluid and lights must be fully operational and track ready
- _____ Tires must be in good condition and inflated to proper air pressures
- _____ Lug nuts must all be present and have proper thread engagement
- _____ Steering and suspension components must not exhibit play
- _____ Fluids must be filled to minimum levels and not cause any dripping leaks
- _____ Snell certified helmet, closed toe shoes and valid driver's license
