Pre-tech Inspection Must be performed NOT MORE than 30 days prior to the event

- ___ Structural Integrity: no loose body or interior parts; no structural rust at or near suspension points.
- ___ Doors: must be operational from inside and outside.
- ___ Windshield: no cracks, condition does not impair vision.
- ___ Mirrors: minimum of single mirror in good condition and securely mounted.
- ___ Gas Cap: tightly closed and no leakage.
- ___ Fluids: NO DRIPPING LEAKS of any fluid of any type; oil, gas, brake, coolant or transmission.
- ___ Fluid Lines: proper fittings and line condition; no external clamps used on pressurized oil lines.
- ___ Battery: properly secured; no apparent corrosion.
- ___ Throttle Return: freely operating and proper spring(s).
- ___ Belts: fan and other auxiliary belts in good condition with proper tension.
- ___ Brakes: Sufficient brake pads (> 50%); rotors and pads are in good condition; no cuts or abrasions in brake lines.
- ___ Rotors: Greater than min thickness. There should be no visible cracks extending to the edge of the rotor.
- ___ Brake Fluid: Sufficient brake fluid; premium fluid recommended. Brake fluid must be changed at least annually (12mo.)

- ___ Brake Lights: functional and visible brake lights.
- ___ Pedals: All pedals must have free return and be in good operating condition. Brake pedal must be firm.
- ___ Wheels-Overall Condition: no cracks, bends or flaws;
- ___ Wheel Bolts & Lugs: all lug nuts or bolts engaged; pay special attention to after-market wheels
- ___ Wheel Center locks: make sure locking devices are fully engaged.
- ___ Wheel Bearings: proper free rotation; no looseness in hub.
- ___ Tires: general good condition; no cracks, cuts, cords or blisters; (usable tread 3/32" min) Front and Rear match.
- ___ Suspension: no excessive play; ball joints and tie rods secure; mounting hardware, boots and seals in good condition, no leaks
- ___ Exhaust System: securely fastened and in good condition.
