

# MUSSELMAN HONDA CIRCUIT

## Coronavirus Mitigation Plan

**Pursuant to State of Arizona Executive Order 2020-33 (and subsequent Executive Order 2020-34)**

**Phase I** May 22, 2020

**Phase II** To be developed upon safe and successful implementation of Phase I

**Phase III** If required.

On April 29, 2020, Arizona State Gov. Doug Ducey issued the Executive Order referenced above concerning restrictions related to the coronavirus pandemic. In paragraph 4.i., he stated that Essential Activities included: “Engaging in outdoor activities such as walking, hiking, running, biking or golfing, but only if appropriate physical distancing practices are used;”. Since go-karting, along with other motor sports, is a physically demanding activity practiced entirely outdoors, Musselman Honda Circuit has established this Coronavirus Mitigation Plan to safely comply with Gov. Ducey’s Executive Order in the reopening of its facility.

### **Participants (and Staff where applicable)**

1. The facility shall operate under its existing safety protocol except where it conflicts with this Plan; in the event of a conflict, the provisions of this Plan shall govern.
2. No person shall be allowed at the facility (a) who is sick (b) who shows any current signs of having contracted Covid19 or who (c) resides or is in an intimate relationship with anyone described in the preceding subparagraphs (a) and (b).
3. The facility will be open for practice by experienced track drivers only. No formal racing events will be held during this Phase I. No spectators, unaccompanied minors, or pets will be allowed at the facility at any time.
4. Everyone must arrive by personal vehicle only, with no more than 2 occupants per vehicle. Each vehicle may be parked no closer than ten feet from any other vehicle in any direction.
5. Each track driver, mechanic, coach or observer must sign-in wearing a protective mask. Each track driver must have in his or her possession a functioning and charged mobile phone to be available for use in case of an emergency. Each person signing in must acknowledge that he or she has read, and is in compliance with, the provisions of this Plan by signing a copy prior to leaving registration.
6. Track drivers or accompanying mechanics, coaches, or observers must have their own safety equipment including, at a minimum, a driving helmet with full face shield. Driving gloves are required for all open vehicles such as go karts.
7. Track drivers shall disperse by insuring that their track vehicles, tools, and equipment are at least 10 feet in any direction from any other track driver’s location. The facility has more than adequate space, both in the pit areas and in the participants’ passenger car parking lots, to meet this objective. In this outdoor environment protective masks need not be worn unless there is reason for contact between individuals less than 10

feet away, at which time face masks shall be mandatory for all people within that distance.

8. Track drivers shall use their own track vehicles. Rental track vehicles will be available only on a limited basis and only if the track operator has the necessary personal and supplies present to sanitize all surfaces of any rental vehicle in contact with the rental driver immediately after its use. No safety equipment will be provided for any rental driver. Each such driver must provide his or her own safety equipment as required for all track drivers in paragraph 6. above.
9. One mechanic, coach, or observer may accompany a track driver and work at that driver's location only if he or she is living in the same residence as the track driver, has arrived in the same personal vehicle as the track driver, and has properly signed in as described in paragraph 5. above
10. All personnel shall provide for their own meals and adequate fluids for hydration; the facility will not sell food or drinks under this Phase I of the Plan.

### **Staff**

1. All staff members shall have their own protective masks. Staff shall wear masks when signing in participants and all times when interacting with participants within a radius of 10 feet.
2. All high touch surfaces at the sign-in location and in both restrooms shall be thoroughly sanitized every 2 hours or more often as required. Common writing implements used at sign-in shall be sanitized after each person's use. Staff shall use hand sanitizer throughout each day for their protection and the protection of participants.
3. Dedicated activity hours as well as open hours will be posted on the track website at [mhcircuit.com](http://mhcircuit.com) under the heading Calendar. Dedicated activities will group go-karts and motorcycles on one weekend evening and time attack and drifting on the alternate weekend evening.
