



## Schedule & Rules for Open Car Events

### General Night Event Schedule

- 2:30pm Gates Open  
There is an entry fee of \$5.00 per person (participants and spectators). Every person entering park must sign our release waiver before entry.
- 3:00pm to 3:30pm Registration & Tech Inspection  
All registered cars must go through Tech and be approved for track entry
- 3:30pm Mandatory Driver's Meeting  
This meeting is mandatory for all drivers. We will brief you on the track conditions, general rules, flags, and a recap of safe track entry and exit. EVERYONE entering park must attend our driver's meeting.
- 4:00pm On-Track Sessions Begin  
You will be assigned a group designation and will only be allowed on track during your group's time allotment. Gate crossings will be at the top of each hour.
- 7:00pm End of Day  
Time to pack up and head home; we hope you had a great time! Park must be vacated by 8:00pm

### General Event Rules

- Drivers and passengers must wear seat belts and helmets while on hot pit and track.
- Passengers must be 16 years of age or older and provide picture I.D.
- Absolutely no back-seat passengers.
- Vehicle occupants will not be permitted to enter track surface area if they did not attend the driver's meeting and sign appropriate waivers. (No exceptions/No refunds)
- Vehicles are subject to inspection at any time. Convertibles without roll bars are not allowed.
- Loose parts or panels and fluid leaks of any kind are not permitted on track. Any oil or fuel spill must be cleaned and reported immediately.
- No passing in corners; hand signal passing in straight-away areas only.
- Burn-outs, drifting, and skidding are not permitted.
- No reckless driving/speeding/staging/racing on driveway or Pilgrim Lane while entering or entering facility (please be respectful of our neighbors!)
- Damage to any portion of the facility or grounds (structures/track surface/paddock/grass) will be billed directly to the person(s) responsible at the time of occurrence. Payment for damages will be collected immediately.
  - Tires are not to leave track surface. First offence will receive a warning. Second offence may suspend driving privileges for rest of day and/or may be charged \$60 per incident.
  - Corner and brake markers will be billed at \$30.00 each.
- Towing will be available by way of utility vehicle and tow strap. First incident may not incur a fee; subsequent incidences will be \$30.00 each and to be paid at time of service. We are not responsible for any damage of any kind.

### General Facility Rules

- Alcohol use is not permitted by drivers or spectators during event/hot-track hours.
- All of TGPR grounds are dedicated as a No Drone Zone.
- Animals must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after them! No pets allowed in any buildings.
- Speed limit in the pit and paddock area is 10 MPH. All pit bike and ATV riders will wear a helmet
- No standing or sitting on hot pit wall. No loitering on hot pit road.
- All children must be supervised at all times. No children under 16 years on hot pit road during event hours.
- Power is available: 50A/\$50 - 30A/\$30 - 20A/\$20. First come, first serve.
- Campers, toy haulers, tents, and canopies are allowed. Please bring tie downs for canopies.
- No open pipes.
- Motorized vehicles are not permitted on track after event hours.
- The track will be one-way traffic at all times unless authorized by TGPR Management.
- We do not sell gas and have no provision for used fluids so please be prepared to bring fuel and take used fluids with you at the end of the day. All tires, oil, fuel (including oil cans and fuel cans) must be removed from TGPR grounds upon leaving the event. NO DUMPING anywhere on TGPR grounds at any time. Extra fees may be charged to for violations.

**\*\*Non-adherence to these Rules could result in loss of track privileges or ejection from the park.\*\***

**\*\*Loss of track time due to crashes, spills, mechanical issues (yours or other drivers) will not be reimbursed.\*\***
