

# Welcome to the April 14, 2022 CCC Track Day!

Please read the following guidelines to help make your track day go smoother.

Make sure your car meets all requirements on the TECH sheet included in your registration! If it doesn't, you will NOT be allowed on track!

Bring with you: your valid driver's license, color printed TECH sheet completely filled out and signed

Upon arrival go to CHECK-IN FIRST

- 1. Empty everything out of your car, including any empty soda cans or water bottles underneath the seats, cell phones (you may keep them in your pocket but you should silence them), and anything else that may fly, flit, roll, talk, ring, bang, rumble, rattle, and crunch!
- 2. Take your TECH sheet, yourself and your car to get teched.
- 3. Your assigned car number will be put on your car by tech.
- 4. Please, please keep your eye on your schedule. Where you are supposed to be, what you are supposed to do, and at what time you are supposed to do it is colored for your particular group, and while you're at it, keep your ears open for any announcements over the P.A.
- 5. Driver's meetings and classes are mandatory, held in the classrooms and you will not be allowed out on the track unless you attend.
- 6. Drink plenty of fluids the night before and during the day-of event...very important!
- 7. The only other person in your car besides you will be a CCC instructor. No other passengers. Only paid participants are eligible to be able to go for a ride during the day with one of the instructors. 18 and older only, no exceptions.
- 8. Any questions? Ask an instructor, they would be happy to help you.

## Track conduct governed by Summit Point Motorsports Park and the Pit Marshal's judgment

You and your car Must be and remain compliant with ALL Event Requirements stated in your registration

#### **Flags**

Green- Session is open. Displayed at Start/Finish
 Yellow-Standing- Caution-Danger ahead off paved surface, Slow

Great Caution-Danger ahead **ON** the paved surface, the track may be blocked,

Yellow-WavingSlow, prepare to take evasive action. No passing until you reach the next manned

flag station that is not displaying a Yellow Flag.

White- Service vehicles or other slow-moving vehicles ahead on the track

Another driver would like to pass you, if safe and appropriate, give a point by and use good

track etiquette and get off the throttle

\* Black-Furled- Conduct Warning -will only be displayed at Start/Finish and \*Black Flag station pointed at

you PIT-IN Consultation with Pit Marshal. Displayed at Start/Finish and Black Flag station

Black-Open- pointed at you and may include a # board for mechanical or conduct issues.

The "Meatball" (Black /Orange Ball) flag may be used.

❖ Black-Full Course- ALL cars Pit-in. Displayed at all stations and may be waving

Red-Full Course- All cars come to a controlled STOP at the edge of the track but still on the surface with-

in sight of a flag station (not in a place to blind other drivers). STAY PUT, Await signal from a flag station Course Marshal. This requires a high degree of situational awareness to

avoid creating a secondary incident

Checker- Session is over -Pit-In. Displayed at Start/Finish. Passing rules still in effect.

#### **PASSING: Summit Point Circuit**

#### **ALL GROUPS**

Passing is allowed only with a point-by from the driver of the lead car, one car per point-by, in designated passing zones per group. All passes must be completed before the braking zone for the next turn. The lead driver always stays on line. The lead driver will surrender the side he has pointed to <u>until the pass is completed</u>. It is the responsibility of the overtaking driver to move off line, pass, and move back on line within the allowed space. Drivers of high-powered cars need to lift off the throttle to aid the overtaking car. ALL drivers are expected to be **safe and courteous** 

**Designated Passing Zones:** (Subject to revision. If in doubt check with the course supervisor.)

#### **GROUP 1 (Novice) and GROUP 2 (Intermediate)**

- 1. Between Turns 10-11 Overtaking car moves to pass on driver's Left
- 2. Between Turns 11-12 Overtaking car moves to pass on driver's Left
- 3. Between Turns 14-1 Overtaking car moves to pass on driver's Right

#### **GROUP 2 Bonus Passing Zone**

• Turn 4-5 Overtaking car moves to pass on driver's Right

These passing areas require additional judgement and cooperation critical for a driver's growth toward Group 3.

#### **GROUP 3 (Solo)**

Must occur anywhere wheels are straight.

#### **INSTRUCTOR Sessions**

Must occur anywhere wheels are straight.

**NOTE**: Instructors are allowed to take students and guests 18 and older as passengers during the instructor session. Passengers allowed in cars that have protection for passenger equal to the driver.
