Event Specifics

Event Description: The **Track Event** will include non-timed lapping (Test & Tune) sessions for **licensed racers**. Groups will include Open Wheel and Closed Wheel GCR compliant Competition cars. We reserve the right to move car classes from group to group depending on entries.

The **Time Trial** will include only Time Attack track sessions. Groups will be **limited to Intermediate, and Advanced Drivers**. Passing Zone rules will apply equally to the entire group. After the timed practice, Time Trial cars will be gridded based on fastest time first.

Gates open at 5:00 PM on Thursday 7/30/2020. On site Check In is open from 6:30 – 8:30 PM Thursday evening and again from 7:00 to 10:00 AM on Friday 7/31/2020. A draft version of the session schedule is available. A final schedule will be provided at check-in. We expect at least four on-track sessions per group during the event. We'll do everything possible to ensure that everyone gets maximum track time. However, events outside of our control might change the number of sessions we can fit into the schedule. The schedule is subject to change during the event, so please listen for PA announcements.

Activities and Inspections: Self Tech form submissions take place Thursday night from 7 to 8:30 PM and Friday from 7 to 9 AM in the Tech Building. Due to State of Ohio Social Distancing Guidelines, this plan is subject to change. Also, we regret that there will not be a formal social event at the end of the day.

Or, you may contact the Ambassador at jenniferdietz96@hotmail.com to request a paper registration form. ****PLEASE NOTE: ONLINE REGISTRATION IS HIGHLY ENCOURAGED AND WILL RECEIVE PRIORITY OVER PAPER REGISTRATIONS****. If more than 35 cars register for the Time Trial, we will offer a wait-list. If available, wait-listed drivers will be contacted at least 48 hours prior to the start of the event. **On-line Registration closes** on 7/29/2020. **Entry Fees:** Track Day Entry: \$200.00, Non-members must purchase an SCCA Weekend membership for \$15.00. **Refunds & Withdrawals:** Available prior to on-track participation.

Time Trial Car Classes: All car classes listed in the National Car Class Rules are allowed. The Time Trial will NOT allow open-wheel vehicles that are listed as “not allowed” in the National Car Class Rules. If you need clarification about your vehicle’s eligibility, review the Rules or contact the Event Lead or Ambassador.

Additional Rules: Transponders are required for the Time Trial. If you don’t have a Tranx260 compatible transponder, you may rent one through MotorsportsReg.com for \$25 for the event. All cars also must display a number on both sides of the car. Numbers should be 8 inches high in a color that contrasts with the car’s paint. Masking tape numbers are acceptable as long as they are readable.

Awards: Awards will be presented per the Time Trials website. Due to Social Distancing Guidelines in the State of Ohio, awards will be distributed to competitors after the event.

Elements Common to both Track Day and Time Trials

Notice to Participants: *In light of the current COVID-19 situation, every attempt will be made to minimize the risks of exposure to the virus. New processes and procedures are being developed and will be put into place for events going forward.*

Ultimately, it is your responsibility to assess the risk to you, both on-track and off, and to make the decision on whether or not to participate. If you are feeling unwell or are experiencing symptoms such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath please stay home. If you have been in contact with someone who has been experiencing these symptoms in the last two weeks, please stay home.

While on site please take the health and safety of your fellow participants, volunteers and staff into consideration and practice social distancing, wear a mask, and wash your hands and/or use hand sanitizer frequently.

Grid & Pit Lane Rules:

1. All Time Trial cars entering the track during “hot” sessions must have an appropriate Tech Sticker.
2. Only participants with the appropriate wristband will be allowed in Grid, Pits and on Track.
3. The Grid Steward positioned at the entrance to the Pit area controls traffic through the gate. Drivers must follow the instructions of the Grid Steward before proceeding into the Pit area.
4. Be aware at all times of foot traffic in the Pit and Paddock areas.
5. No uncredentialed minors are allowed on Grid or in the Pit Lane during activities.

Paddock Rules: Paddock speed limit is “walking speed” and it is strictly enforced. Only licensed drivers may operate any type of motorized vehicles in the paddock. Please place wood or other material between any jacks and the asphalt. If you have a fluid spill, please contact an event official immediately. Oil dry is available. The organizers and the track management are not responsible for damage or theft of equipment or belongings. Speeding in the pit/paddock/access roads, and reckless driving (even on track) are strictly prohibited and could result in removal from the property.

Track Rules: Once track sessions have started, all access to the Paddock will be via the crossover gate between live sessions.

Services on or near the track: 93 Octane Fuel will be available for sale at the track. Parts stores and other services are available in the towns of Garrettsville and Warren nearby.

Camping & Accommodations: Camping is available for participants (including volunteers) at the track. Arrangements should be made with track management by contacting the Track Manager (fredwolfe917@gmail.com). All campfires must be in above ground fire rings, not on the ground. Area hotels can be found via the map function on MotorsportsReg.com.

Pets: Nelson Ledges is a pet friendly track. In fact, so pet friendly that your pet may get a biscuit when it shows up. That being said, pets must be on a leash or a lead at all times. Please clean up after your pet. The next person who has to slide under a car to make a repair doesn't want to find the gift Fido left behind.

Event Cancellation: The organizers reserve the right to cancel or postpone the event when circumstances arise that are beyond their control. If at all possible, entrants will be notified in advance and refund arrangements will be made as needed.
