IMPORTANT EVENT NOTES:

- 103 dB sound limit enforced
- 1st TA session is practice, all subsequent sessions are scored
- No passengers allowed
- Camping is available
- TA transponders provided

- The Tower Paddock (NOT the infield paddock) will be used for all drivers

REGISTRATION: Each driver can expect approximately 105 min of seat time. Registration for this event can be accessed directly at <https://msreg.com/26ATLTRA1>. If you have not previously registered for one of our events via Motorsportsreg.com, you will be prompted to create an account to register. When registering please verify that your car information, car #, transponder info, email, payment info, and cell phone are still accurate.

ENTRY FEE: The Time Attack entry fee is \$345 per driver. If you have any questions or issues, please contact the Event Registrar at AtlantaSCCATT@gmail.com. If you do not have an annual SCCA membership, then a weekend SCCA membership is required (for an additional \$25).

REFUND POLICY: You will not be charged until you check in, so there is NO penalty for registering as early as possible. If you sign in at registration and elect not to go on track for the SCCA event, please notify the Admin via e-mail, text, or phone at your earliest opportunity (before leaving the track, if possible).

TIMING & SCORING: The transponders we use for this event are MyLaps/AMB TranX260 or X2 Transponders. Need a transponder? We have you covered! We provide rental transponders to all TA competitors to ensure accurate gridding & scoring. If you have your own transponder, awesome! Please make sure to fill in the number when you register. Rental transponders will be distributed each morning at the driver's meeting. The red MyLaps transponders should hold a charge for the entire event. Please return transponders to an event official (safety steward, event lead, driver coach, or registrar) before leaving the track. Please go to Timing if you have any transponder questions during the event.

OFF COURSE EXCURSIONS AND SPINS: Any vehicle leaving the paved course area with all four wheels and/or spinning (90° or more) on course shall proceed safely to the Pit Area for discussion with event officials and/or vehicle inspection. Not self-reporting will result in loss of track time or complete sessions. For Time Attack drivers, four tires off the paved track surface or any spin perpendicular or more than 90 degrees to the direction of track will result in a loss of fastest time in that session.

PADDOCK/PARKING INFORMATION: We ask that you work with us to accommodate most of your wishes regarding paddock parking. To that end, paddock parking personnel will assign, and direct parking based on the size of your vehicles per instructions from the Paddock Chief using the following guidelines:

- Single car set-ups will get a spot twenty (20) feet wide that is long enough to accommodate the tow vehicle and trailer if possible. All awnings and support equipment must fit within those confines. This allows the maximum amount of parking in desired areas.
- Multiple car teams and/or participants providing services to the Atlanta Region will be located to maximize their efficiency.
- Paddock spots with power are very limited. The priority is to provide electrical hook-ups to the maximum number of competitors.
- We request that open trailers not actively involved in support of a race vehicle be removed from the main paddock areas. They can be parked along the fence area on either side of the main gate.

- For safety reasons the county Fire Marshal requires that access lanes be kept open. Vehicles parked in no-parking areas will be towed without warning.

TIME ATTACK EVENT FORMAT: For the first session drivers will select their own grid space. Subsequent sessions will be gridded in order by the driver's fastest lap time. Event results will be based on a driver's single best lap time from all scored sessions.

TIME ATTACK RUN GROUPS: First session run groups will be gridded based on driver experience and/or projected lap time. For subsequent sessions, run groups will be gridded based on lap time. The first session will be practice; all subsequent sessions will be scored.

TWO DRIVER CARS: Two driver cars are allowed; however, drivers should be aware that their sessions may be back-to-back. Each driver MUST have their own unique car #. It is up to the two driver teams to manage driver change over, car # changes, and session track time. A single transponder can be shared between two drivers of the same vehicle.

PASSENGERS: Passengers are not permitted.

CAR NUMBERS: There are no Southeast Division permanent number assignments for TA or TD. Car #s are first come, first serve, so register early if you want your preferred car #!

RESULTS: Live timing will be available during the event at [MyLaps speedhive](#) (free) or the speedhive App (free), as well as [Race Monitor](#) (free) or on the Race Monitor app (subscription). Live timing information is neither official nor able to be protested. Results (including grid sheets) will be available here:

AWARDS: Trophies will be awarded to class winners, regardless of number of drivers in class.

PASSING RULES: Passing will be allowed as follows for each group:

- Advanced TA:
 - ◆ Passing anywhere
 - ◆ Point-bys not required on straights
 - ◆ Point-bys required in turns
- Intermediate TA:
 - ◆ Passing anywhere with point-by
- Novice TA:
 - ◆ Straight-only passing with point-by

IMPOUND: At the conclusion of each Time Attack session vehicles will be held in impound for a short session debrief. Track Day drivers may be directed to a brief post-session debrief area.

PIT LANE: Drivers are to maintain a pit lane speed limit of **40 MPH** with **absolutely no racing**.

FLAGS AND THEIR MEANINGS: Please see the SCCA Time Trials Rules of the Track here:

Green - Course is clear.

Yellow, Stationary - An incident is ahead and safety may be at risk, though the track may still be clear. Check your mirrors, slow noticeably, and proceed cautiously at reduced speed. No passing is allowed from the flag station until past the last part of the incident (car, driver, workers, vehicles, or debris).

Yellow, Waving - A serious incident is ahead and the track may be partially or fully blocked. Check your mirrors, slow significantly, and be prepared to stop. Proceed in single file. No passing is allowed from the flag station until past the last part of the incident (car, driver, workers, vehicles, or debris).

Blue with Yellow Stripe - The infamous "Miata Flag." This is our passing flag, shown when a faster car is approaching. Please allow it to pass at the next passing zone. Acknowledge the blue flag with a small wave to both the worker and the following car, or the "rearview mirror tap." This courtesy prevents tailgating, mirror driving, and promotes safety and reduces aggression.

Yellow with Red Stripes - The "Debris Flag." A slippery surface or debris is present on track. The hazard may still exist even after the flag is withdrawn.

White - A slow-moving or emergency vehicle is ahead. Check your mirrors, slow down, and do not pass.

Black, Rolled Up & Pointed - You have done something not desired by that particular corner station. Please do not do it again, else you may see the unfurled black flag. You DO NOT have to report to the pit after seeing the "naughty" flag.

Black, Unfurled - You must enter the pits at the next opportunity to consult with an event official.

Black with Orange Circle - The "meatball." This flag indicates that there is a mechanical issue with your car. Please proceed to the pit where a driver coach will be available to assist.

Red - EXTREME DANGER. The session has been stopped. Check your mirrors, safely slow down, and stop within sight of a staffed corner station. The Red Flag will remain out until all cars have stopped. Then proceed cautiously to pit lane when directed by a waving black flag.

Checkered - Displayed at the end of a session to indicate that the session is finished. Continue at reduced speed to help cool the car and pit immediately.

TECHNICAL INSPECTION, DRIVER AND CAR ELIGIBILITY

TECH FORMS: All drivers must complete a tech form and turn it into check-in. Each driver will need to provide their own tech form, even if sharing one vehicle. Tech forms for both Time Attack & Track Day can be found here:

For items that don't apply to your car (IE, roll bar & padding in a car without a roll bar), please indicate "N/A" for these items. Please be sure to complete EVERY SECTION, ESPECIALLY your helmet rating, and PRINT, SIGN, & DATE when complete.

SOUND CONTROL: Sound Control is in effect at this event. All cars must not exceed 103 db.

DRIVER ELIGIBILITY: All drivers must be at least 18 years of age and have a valid state driver's license and a full or weekend SCCA membership (Section 4 applies). A SCCA TA License, NASA TT License (Full), SCCA Road Race Novice or Full Competition License, or competition licenses from other sanctioning bodies per the General Competition Rules is accepted. TA licenses will not be issued at the event, but can be requested in advance.

To request a SCCA TA license, please go to <https://timetrials.scca.com/pages/driver-eligibility> (towards the bottom of the page) and submit a licensing request.

CAR ELIGIBILITY: Vehicles must meet the appropriate safety requirements for their TA Class. Requirements can be found here: <https://timetrials.scca.com/pages/national-event-safety-rules>

GRID: No fueling of cars on the grid. No tractors, electric carts, or any other vehicles used to tow race cars or transport parts, or related equipment will be allowed access to the grid.

PASSES: The entry fee entitles each entry to five (5) passes to include all drivers, entrant, and crew members as applicable. Only SCCA members will be issued crew credentials (weekend members are eligible). Non-members will receive visitor/guest passes and may not enter hazardous (hot) areas. Members and non-members must wear their credentials/passes visibly at all times. Credentials are valid only for the person to whom they are issued. Credential fraud of any kind will result in a penalty to anyone involved.

- **MINORS:** Any minor over the age of 12 will be counted as one of the five passes allowed per entry.
- **WAIVERS:** Any participant or guest of a participant entering the property without buying a ticket must sign a waiver at registration.
- **ADDITIONAL PASSES:** This is a spectator event. Additional crew passes will be available at Registration for \$20.00 each during Registration hours. To minimize confusion and/or hard feelings, PLEASE inform all your crew & friends of our registration hours.
- **AFTER REGISTRATION CLOSES:** Participants, along with occupants in the vehicle, who arrive with 'race cars in tow' after registration is closed will be able to enter the facility by signing a waiver at the gate. Please be cognizant of your paddock neighbors when parking. All occupants of the vehicle must go to SCCA registration when it opens to receive credentials and be registered for the weekend.
- **FREE ENTRY:** SCCA members, retired military (including family), and active military (including family) will be admitted free of charge with appropriate identification. Valid Identification must be presented at SCCA Registration during SCCA Registration hours.
- **SPECTATOR TICKETS:** Can be purchased from Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta for \$25 each for the 2-day event, or \$15 for either Saturday or Sunday (one day only).
- **TRACK TOURS:** Will be scheduled during lunch on Saturday as time and conditions permit. Copies of the Track Tour procedures will be available at Tech and/or at Registration. All participants must sign waivers and a \$20 per car donation to the Atlanta Region SCCA Workers Fund will be collected. Exact change is appreciated. Event volunteers may participate in the track tours at no charge.

GENERAL INFORMATION

COURSE: 2.54 Mile Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta Full Circuit

FUEL: Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta has automatic (credit card) pumps for both unleaded (93, 96, and 100 octane) and leaded (110 octane) VP racing gas. Look for the blue Sunoco canopy in the Tower paddock.

TRACK RULES

- **PAVEMENT & WASTES:** Do not drive stakes into the pavement. Always use wood blocks or metal plates to prevent pavement damage from jacks and jackstands. Do not spill oil, coolant, or fuel onto pavement or ground. Please make provisions for removing from the premises any used tires, fuel, brake fluid, solvents, hazardous waste products, and batteries. If you do have an accidental spill, please notify an event official.
- **PER GEORGIA STATE LAW:** Entrants must have a fire extinguisher with a minimum rating of 10ABC visible in their paddock area.
- **RESTRICTED HOURS:** Hall County ordinance prohibits running race engines between 8:00 PM and 7:45 AM. It also prohibits running race engines from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM on Sundays. Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta gates will be locked at 8:00 PM on the last day of the event. Please be off the premises by that time or contact track security to make arrangements for extended hours.
- **OTHER RESTRICTIONS:** Per track policy, there is a strict 5 MPH speed limit on all personal ATVs, bicycles, mopeds, scooters, or other personal transportation devices AND **riders must wear a suitable helmet at all times**. Pets are allowed only in the paddock area and must always be leashed when not inside a vehicle. No glass containers are allowed on the property. Skateboards, passenger-carrying wagons, and skates are prohibited in the paddock, pit, and grid areas. The operation of any vehicle (including bicycles) by persons not holding a valid State Operator's Permit is prohibited. Track policies that may not be known at the time of writing of these Supplementary Regulations will supersede any rules stated here.
- **PARTICIPANT, CREW, & GUEST CONDUCT & INTOXICANTS:** Any participant using intoxicants before their race group or assigned duties are over each day is subject to disqualification from the event and ejection from the property. Use of illegal drugs is specifically prohibited during the event. Anyone using illegal drugs is subject to disqualification and ejection from the property. Drivers are responsible for their crew. Volunteers are responsible for their guests. Impound and Registration are race activities. Smoking is prohibited indoors as well as in Tech, Grid, Pit Lane and within 20 feet of the Media Center/Tower and Registration.
