

## CSCC Autoslalom COVID-19 Procedures

Following what many clubs have instituted and to ensure the safety of those volunteering/participating in the autoslalom, the CSCC will be abiding by the regulations set up by the Government of Alberta. Outlined below are a few rules that coincide with AHS regulations that volunteers/participants will need to follow:

1. Participants/Volunteers must remain 6ft apart from each other.
2. Masks are highly recommended, especially if staying 6ft apart is not possible.
  - a. Masks will be available at the event if participants/volunteers are unable to bring their own.
3. Hand sanitizer will be available at each event. We recommend you bring your own as well.
4. An Alberta health daily checklist will need to be filled out and emailed to the event organizer the day before the event.
  - a. Please ensure the event number and date is indicated on the form.

5. Self tech forms can be sent electronically prior to the event, but if you are unable to send via email, a volunteer will be available to accept in person.
6. Please fill out the general waiver form located on the registration site and email to [betsy.nguyen@csc.ab.ca](mailto:betsy.nguyen@csc.ab.ca) the day before the event.
  - a. Please ensure the event number and event date are on the form.
7. Sharing tools is prohibited.
8. Loaner helmets will be available per person for one day use only, and sharing of all/any helmets is prohibited.
9. All ride along passengers must be from the same household.
10. If you are feeling unwell at the event, we ask that you text the organizer to let them know, then return home to self-isolate.

### Check-in:

1. At the gate you will be directed to a dedicated parking stall.
2. If you were unable to fill out the general waiver form electronically, we will have one available at the registration desk.
  - a. Please bring your own pen to fill out the waiver form.
3. Drivers meeting will be conducted at a distance via megaphone.
4. If you have any questions during the event, please raise your hand and a volunteer will come to assist you, or you may call the number (587) 402-5929.

### Volunteer Procedure

1. Radios will be sanitized prior to pick up from volunteers.
2. When picking up your radio we ask that you form a single file line and maintain 6ft apart.
3. Volunteers must hand in their radio for sanitizing before the next volunteer group is to pick up their radio.
4. Please ensure that volunteer positions remain 6ft apart from each other.
5. Scoring station will be sanitized prior to each usage.
6. Once the volunteers have finished returning their radios, they must stay within the parameters of their parking area. A non-competing volunteer will then signal to the drivers to begin the next round.
