

**DRIVER'S LETTER**  
**ROEBLING ROAD SUMMER RACES**  
**JUNE 26-28, 2020**

The Southeast Division is "Back on Track" and is excited to welcome you to the Roebling Road Summer Races and to the remainder of the 2020 season.

As we open the gates, here is the plan. We are going to be kind and patient with each other; we are going to be considerate of event volunteers and staff. There are a lot of new policies and procedures in this Covid-19 environment that we must adapt to. Please keep a positive mind and we are all going to enjoy everything great competition has to offer.

All of you have made racing in the Southeast special over the years, and above all else, we want you to help us prove that we are the safest place on track and in the paddock.

With that said, we encourage everyone to follow safe practices at Roebling Road, such as social distancing (maintaining six feet from others), frequent hand washing, and the wearing of your face mask covering your nose and mouth at all times whenever you are not in your individual paddock space. Please remember per GCR 2.2.2 as the driver you are responsible for your crew and guests during the event.

We have all been off the track for awhile and while excited to be back on track our skill levels may be a bit rusty. Be respectful of your fellow drivers. Leave that extra bit of room on a pass.

Please before arriving look at your GCR, Appendix P for the new, Racing Room & Passing Guidelines. This is an important new addition created by drivers for drivers and officials to use as a guide for on track incidents.

Remember GCR 6.11.1.E Rules of the Road, that if you are involved in a metal to metal incident on track during a session to report to the Chief Steward at the end of the session.

Registration will be held at the Registration Building. The first table you will come to will be for your temperature to be checked and information taken. Please have all your information ready to be presented. Please maintain social distancing while in line. There will only be three Registrars, so please be patient.

After completing registration proceed to find your paddock space in an orderly fashion.

Your Tech Card will be found at tech. If you have a current annual tech you will only need your helmet and logbook at tech. If you need an annual tech for your car, these will be done by appointment only through Jim Creighton. Jim will be available at his motorhome for appointments.

Impound – following all races top three cars in each class will be required to report to impound. If cars are held, only one crew member will be permitted to stay with the car and driver. We hope to have bottled water available for drivers during impound, but you may also want to have a crew member bring water to impound for you as well. It's summer and it's Roebing Road so please drink plenty of water and stay hydrated during the weekend.

Timing & Race Results – results will be posted on the Bulletin Board as you enter the paddock. All sessions will also be timed and available via Race Hero and Race Monitor.

Any communication with drivers during the event will be made by way of email, PA announcements and written driver's meeting.

There **will not** be a driver's meeting on Saturday. This letter will be your drivers meeting.

There will be a social Saturday evening. You and all of your crew and family and friends are encouraged to come and join us. Please give the volunteer workers a big thank you at the party. Food will be provided box style, so all you have to do is pick up a box. There will be cold beverages available. We continue to encourage social distancing limiting close contact at the social. If you have a chair please feel free to bring it with you.

Again, we are glad you have chosen to attend the Southeast Division's Roebing Road Summer Races. Please stay safe and have fun both on and off the track this weekend.
