## **WOW DRIVER MEETING NOTES - TRACK LAPS SINGLE LAP RUNS**

This track time is developed for those that have little to no experience being on a racetrack. There is no pressure to set the fastest lap, just an opportunity to enjoy what you can do in your car.

This information will count as your driver's meeting – so please read it carefully!

- You must have your arm band for the day this will be provided when you check-in
- You must have the appropriate color sticker for your session, this sticker needs to be placed at the top of the windshield on the drivers' side this will be provided when you check-in
- Cars must have both windows rolled down prior to leaving the start line
- If you feel that you have a mechanical issue with your vehicle while on track, pull to the left or right side of
  the racetrack and stay in your car our corner marshals will report, and we will have fire/rescue come to
  your aid.
  - PLEASE NOTE there is no charge by the racetrack if you get towed off the track, this is just part
    of what we do!
  - o If you are on fire this is the ONLY time you can get out of your vehicle
- If you are leaking any fluid, please remove your car from the asphalt and pull off onto the dirt/gravel. If you choose to leak fluid on the asphalt you will be charged for the clean-up.
- You are participating at your own risk; any incidents or damages are your responsibility.
  - You damage track property you pay for repairs
  - You damage your vehicle you pay for repairs.
- Drivers having trouble keeping their cars on the racetrack will be black flagged and reported
- PIT LANE SPEED LIMIT IS 35 MPH!!
- No Passing If there is a chance that you come up on a slow driver, please be patient and do NOT pass them – we will ensure to provide you with a large gap for your next lap
- Parking on the right-hand side of pit road in the designated spots during your session is to check your vehicle for any issues, or during a session break
- Please always remember good social distancing
- Have a great time!!

## **FLAGS**



GREEN FLAG – Track is hot, you may begin your session. Corner stations will waive this to show you are located



YELLOW FLAG – **NOT** WAIVING There is a potential danger off the racing line – Proceed with caution



YELLOW FLAG – WAIVING Denotes urgency, there is immediate danger on the racing line or impact zone. Slow down

**NOTE** – You are under the control of the either yellow flag situation until you have passed the incident



RED FLAG – STOP. Bring the car to a quick by safe stop on either side of the track. Do not get out of your car, wait for an official for directions



BLACK FLAG – This flag will be displayed at you, if there is an issue with your driving or your car.
