Team Continental Track Time Trials Format and Car Classifications

- Runs groups formatted like a track day Advanced, Intermediate and Novice. Placement in run groups is based on experience level.
- Cars are classed into brackets by lap times after the first timed track session. Within each run group (Advanced, Intermediate, Novice) there will be three (3) brackets separated by 2-3 seconds from the slowest car in the higher bracket to the fastest car in the next lower bracket. More brackets may be added based on entry levels. If you break out of your bracket you will be moved up to the next higher bracket.
- All cars will be allowed any modification or tire they choose. Brackets are based solely on lap times.
- Transponders (a device that attaches to your car and records your time when the car crosses the start/finish line) are required. These are available to rent - please reserve at the time you register on motorsportreg.
- Trophies will be awarded to the top three (3) in each bracket in each run group. Trophies also awarded to the Fast 5 overall and a special award to the Top Dog for fastest lap of the day.
- Open wheel and sports racing cars may participate but will not be allowed to compete for Fast 5 or Top Dog awards.
