SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Entry Information

Event: “The Halloween 1.5 hour Enduro” will be a 1.5 hour endurance race utilizing the SCCA Club Race Experience Rules.

Cost: The cost per team is \$240 for Enduro only entrants and \$150 for entrants who also are participating in the Halloween Divisional Road Races.

Vehicle Eligibility: The event is open to production-based cars, SCCA Spec Racers, and small bore GT cars meeting SCCA Road Racing Safety requirements found at <https://www.scca.com/pages/race-experience-vehicle-requirements>. Open Wheel Formula Cars, Prototypes, and Pro Series cars are not appropriate for this event. If you have questions about your specific car, please contact the registrar, and your questions will be sent to the appropriate organizer.

Class Structure: The four SCCA National Team Enduro Classes will be used for this event. Please go to www.scca.com/pages/enduro-national-classing and use the calculator to determine which class your car meets. For vehicles which fit the general speed range, but are not eligible for Team Enduro Classes (e.g. its running on Dot-R tires with less than 200TW) they may run in an Exhibition Class. For any recognized and eligible SCCA GCR or regional class with more than five entries, that class will be added to the event. (E.G., if Spec Miata has five entries, they will bump into their own class).

Driver Required Equipment: This event requires drivers to meet the required gear and age requirements found at: <https://www.scca.com/pages/race-experience-driver-safety-gear>.

Vehicle Inspection: Before being allowed on track, each vehicle will need to go through a Safety Inspection. Vehicles with a current SCCA Annual Tech Inspection in their Log Book will be honored in place of the Safety Inspection.

Timing and Scoring: AMB transponders will be used for race scoring and must be used. Vehicles without a working transponder will not be scored.

Mandatory Pit Stop: Each car will be required to perform a minimum of one Pit Stop for a minimum of three minutes. Maximum speed in pit lane is 35 MPH. The Pit Stop begins at the first loop marked with a pylon and ends at the exit loop in the pit lane also marked with a pylon at Pit Out.

Fueling – Fueling is allowed during the race and may be included in this Mandatory Pit Stop. The procedures for Fueling for this event can be found in the SCCA National Team Enduro Rules in section 4.4.B on page 40. Due to the length of this event we will lower the mandatory time of a re-fueling stop to three minutes.

Co-Drivers: Multiple drivers are allowed and encouraged for this event. We will be using the SCCA National Team Enduro Rule covering Pit Stops in section 4.4.

Starting Lineup: The Race Grid will be determined by lap times from Saturday’s practice/qualifying session. Teams that are entered with the same car and driver in the Halloween Divisional may elect to use their times earned during Saturday’s Divisional Race Qualifying Session.

Registration & Schedule: Registration and day of event schedule for this event will use the same schedule as the Halloween Divisional Races (see MSR).

Payments and Refunds: Payments will be made by check or through Motorsports Registration site. Credit Cards will be charged at the time of check in. Refunds will be granted as described in the Terms and Conditions section on MSR.
