Policy: This tire list is intended to allow WIC racers with a reasonable choice of competitive tires that are suitable for their particular make and model. It is not possible to list every tire that might be used legally on every car. The listed tires represent commonly used and available tires that allow fair racing amongst cars in a particular race group and class, and that also closely resemble the tires that a car would have raced on historically. Since the makeup of race groups and classes consists of cars with varying specifications, not every car in a race group or class will necessarily have the same tire options. Because tire availability is a constantly moving target, this list is not absolute. Racers are encouraged to report problems with availability, suitability and performance of the listed tires.
