EVENT ORGANIZER: Buccaneer Region, SCCA, Roebling Road Raceway 1135 Roebling Road, Bloomingdale, GA 31302. Chief Steward: Mark Eversoll.

<u>RULES:</u> This event is governed by the 2016 General Competition Rules and the category specifications as amended by any subsequent racing bulletins listed in FasTrack during the year; the 2016 South Atlantic Road Racing Championship Rules (for SARRC races); the 2016 South East Championship Series SECS. They can be found at http://www.scca.com/pages/cars-and-rules and www.sedivracing.org.

<u>DRIVER ELIGIBILITY:</u> Each SECS/SARRC driver must be a current SCCA member, and must also hold a current SCCA Competition License per the GCR or a current license from an organization recognized by SCCA (see GCR 3.1.2 and FastTrack updates for the complete list). The SCCA requirement is satisfied by SCCA Probation letters and SCCA Novice Permits with Drivers School requirements signed off. Novice permit holders must turn in their novice permits to Registration at the beginning of the event, and must obtain them from the Chief Steward at the end of the event. Weekend SCCA memberships are available.

<u>CAR ELIGIBILITY:</u> All cars eligible for recognized SCCA, SEDiv, and Regional classes are invited to compete at all SARRC events. Groups with less than 12 cars may be combined into other groups. SARRC or SECS decals as appropriate must be displayed on both sides of the car. Officials may disallow and competitors may protest cars not displaying SARRC or SECS decals as not being an eligible vehicle. All drivers entering SARRC are required to have a permanently attached SARRC patch on their drivers' suit, above, below or across from the required SCCA patch. ONLY classes eligible for runoffs are eligible to run SECS, points are awarded to runoff eligible classes only. You may NOT run SECS/SARRC concurrently. SECS cars must display decal on rear except open wheel vehicles.

<u>TRANSPONDERS</u> AMB transponders are required for this event and must be installed and working for each session. If you do not have an AMB transponder, please contact Trackside Tim's in advance at **800-247-4260** or http://www.tracksidetim.com. If your transponder is not working, you may not receive time.

<u>REGISTRATION:</u> Register on-line at <u>www.motorsportreg.com</u>. Please complete all sections of the entry/T&S form. Make checks payable to: Buccaneer Region, SCCA. US bank checks, Traveler's Checks and money orders will be accepted. NO FOREIGN BANK CHECKS ACCEPTED. Returned checks will be assessed a \$30.00 handling fee. **No Debit/Credit cards** accepted. <u>Mail checks to Betsy Speed 200 Robin Road Lincolnton, NC 28092. Phone 704-575-5960 (no calls after 9:00 p.m.)</u> Checks for no-shows will be shredded. Registration closes Tuesday prior to the event. April 19, 2016. Progressive Discounts per driver: 1st \$250, 2nd \$225, 3rd \$200, 4th \$175.

REFUNDS: Refunds will be given at the track only. No refunds if you enter pit road or the track at any entry point.

<u>GATE HOURS:</u> Friday 5:00 p.m. to Sunday 6:00 p.m. Gate Pass issued to each person at the gate prior to or after registration will allow entry to the facility. Anyone entering the track before registration opens or after registration closes must go to Registration by 8:00 A.M. the following day. Due to insurance regulations, only actual participants in the test days prior to SCCA events will be admitted to the track. All other participants may register after the conclusion of Test Day Activities.

PHOTO ID: Must be worn in a visible location by all licensed persons. Arm bands must be worn on membership card or wrist only.

<u>PASSES</u>: Each entry is entitled to four passes. Crew members who are not SCCA members will be required to purchase a full or weekend membership at registration to gain access to the trackside of the pit fence. Only four crew members will be allowed on the trackside of the pit fence. Membership cards must be presented at registration in order to enter the facility. Members and race staff are limited to one quest each.

START/FINISH: Start and finish of races is at the tower on the front straight. Timing and Scoring is located in the Tower on the front straight, second floor. All laps are timed and scored at the Start/Finish line. Transponders will be used for Timing and Scoring.

<u>CHECKERED FLAG &BLACK FLAGS:</u> The checkered flag will be displayed at START/FINISH LINE ending qualifying sessions and races. Black Flags will be shown at Turn 6 and Start/Finish with a number board.

<u>GRID:</u> Cars not in position prior to the 1-minute warning shall relinquish their position and start from the back of the field. Crew MUST move to the rear of the cars as the 1-minute warning is being given. No walking across the Grid area after the 1-minute warning has been given. NO SMOKING ON THE GRID.

<u>CAR NUMBERS:</u> SEDiv permanent numbers will be honored, however this may not be possible due to groups or other changes. Cars not displaying the assigned number from registration will not receive qualifying times. Numbers and Group designation shall be placed and sized according to the GCR. No number changes at the track.

<u>IMPOUND:</u> Is located at the tech shed by the start/finish line. The top three (3) cars in each class for both SARRC & SECS will be required to report to impound until released by Chief Steward, and will be checked for weight. The Chief Steward may require additional inspections or additional cars to report to impound. NO SMOKING IN TECH OR THE IMPOUND AREA.

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<u>AWARDS:</u> Location of the trophy presentations will be at the Tech Shed or Medical Shed across form Tech. Classes pending protest will not be awarded until protests are resolved. **TROPHIES WILL NOT BE MAILED.**

<u>RACE PROCEDURES:</u> All race starts and finishes will be at the start/finish line. In the case of time-limited races, if a race is halted by black flag all or red flag, the race clock will not be stopped.

FACILITIES: Concession, souvenirs, and restrooms with hot-water showers are located in the paddock. Camping is permitted on Friday and Saturday nights. The Track Manager must approve camping on Sunday night. Sunoco GT X 260 ethanol free 98, 110 leaded, 93 fuel is available at the track and credit and debit cards are accepted only for fuel purchases. Electrical outlets are available for rent in the paddock, 30/50 amp electrical outlets are reserved for campers only and all other vehicles will be requested to move. Camping/electrical fees are paid at the gate prior to entry and you must place the sticker on the electric cord.

<u>COMMUNICATIONS:</u> Race Control uses digital radios on **461.825**, **461.025**, **and 464.100 MHz** as licensed for the immediate area by the FCC. For the safety of competitors and race staff, failure to keep these frequencies clear will result in immediate action under the rights specified in the GCR. **DO NOT USE THESE FREQUENCIES FOR PERSONAL COMMUNICATIONS.** Teams are encouraged to monitor race control and alert their drivers of conditions in their track sessions. Race control will be simulcast on FM101.5.

<u>SOUND CONTROL:</u> Is located on driver's left, just past the Start/Finish line. Results will be posted on the bulletin board at the paddock entry. <u>Maximum sound level is 103 dB See GCR 5.7.</u> Non-compliance is subject to disqualification.

ADDITIONAL RULES OF THE PIT AND PADDOCK:

- Crew cannot stand at the white outer pit wall unless signaling a driver. Absolutely NO sitting on the inner blue wall. HOT AREA ARM BAND MUST BE VISIBLEAT ALL TIMES.
- 2. No parallel parking is allowed along the pit/grid fence or the fence area by the gas pumps to turn 3 by vehicles longer than 20 feet. No vehicles are allowed between the concrete wall and the fence.
- 3. Pit support motorized vehicles (ATV's, golf carts, moped, and motorcycles) may only be operated by a person with a valid driver's license and used only for race support. Car # must be displayed on support vehicle at all times. Unauthorized or dangerous use of these vehicles (such as speeding, joy riding, double riding) will result in the vehicle being impounded and the responsible driver being reported to the Chief Steward. **SPEED LIMIT IS 5 MPH.** Support vehicles are not to be used after 8:00 PM. Skateboards, skates, rollerblades, micro/mini racers and go-peds are not permitted.
- 4. Minors under 16 will not be permitted to operate any vehicle, including bicycles.
- 5. DO NOT park in grid access lanes, the roadway behind the concession building, or vendor assigned spaces in the paddock area. Failure to move from any of these areas when requested may result in disqualification. All single car open trailers must be moved to the trailer park located at the East end of the infield paddock. All tractor-trailer parking will be assigned. No iacking of cars on paved access roads.
- 6. Entrants must have a fire bottle displayed in their paddock area with a minimum rating of 10ABC. This is a Georgia State Law.
- 7. No alcoholic beverages are permitted until the last car is off the track at the end of the day.
- 8. Pets must be kept on a leash, controlled by an adult, at all times. The leash may not exceed 10 feet. **NO PETS IN CONCESSION AREA**. Do not walk pet without a visible means to pick up and dispose of pet's waste. Owners are required to pick up and dispose of pet's waste.
- 9. Local ordinance prohibits the running of race engines between 8:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. daily and from 11:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon on Sunday. There is a \$100.00 dollar fine for non-compliance.
- 10. Track rules are posted and will be enforced during this event.
