This event is governed by the 2026 General Competition Rules (GCR) and Category Specifications, as amended per "Fastrack", except as modified by these Supplemental Regulations. This event will be conducted in the spirit of SCCA's Welcoming Environment as shown in the GCR.

All students must have their SCCA Membership in place and successfully complete the Online Drivers School Modules (1 and 2) found in the SCCA Member Portal, SCCA Academy, My Learning, prior to participating in the on-course sessions.

TEST DAY: Brainerd International Raceway (BIR) will offer a test day on Friday, May 22, 2026. This is a track test day and is not covered under the SCCA event sanction and insurance. Please call BIR at 218-824-7223 for additional information.

REGISTRATION and FEES:

ENTRY FEE: \$495

PAYMENTS: Drivers registering using credit cards may register online at: MSR.com. Credit Cards payments are deferred and will not be processed before the event weekend. All entries must be completed in their entirety. Drivers without internet access may request a paper entry form and mail it with their entry fees to BIR. Make checks payable to **Land O' Lakes Region SCCA**. A fee of \$50 will be charged for any check returned by the bank or refused credit card charges, and the entry will also be considered a late entry. Do not mail entries by any method that requires a signature for delivery. Fax entries will not be accepted.

Entries are not official until the entry form is signed/submitted online (electronic signature accepted), received, paid, and accepted. We are not responsible for lost entries, delays in transit, or failed emails. Email entries without a valid credit card number will not be processed. Late fees may be applied in these cases. We will not process credit cards until at least May 20th. All entries for which the payment is not received by 11:59 PM May 19, 2026 will be charged a \$50 late fee, and there may be a delay in processing the registrations at the track. Personal checks, cash, cashier's checks, traveler's checks, and Visa/MasterCard entered online will be accepted for at-track registration.

At-event Registration will be in the registration building located at the main gate.

REFUNDS: If you signed in at registration you are eligible to receive a full refund if you withdraw before your race car touches the track **AND** if you notify the Chief of Registration **BEFORE YOU LEAVE THE TRACK**. If you did not sign in at registration and wish to cancel, cancel your entry thru BIRMN.com or by notifying the Chief Registrar by May 19th, 2026, otherwise you will be charged a \$50 cancellation fee.

DRIVER INFORMATION:

DRIVER ELIGIBILITY: The Drivers School is open to all valid SCCA Members with a valid Novice Permit, and conditionally, those members without holding a Novice Permit. Drivers with valid SCCA Full Competition license, Novice license holders that have completed the school or have an approved full competition license from any organization listed in GCR Appendix.C.2.8.B may enter the Driver School with the approval of the Chief Steward *prior* to submitting entry.

Note: Drivers successfully completing the school requirements without a Novice Permit are not eligible to enter Regional Races. If you know that you want to do the higher levels of Road Racing, for instance, Regional Races, please complete your Novice Permit process with the SCCA National office prior to the event,

CAR ELIGIBILITY: Participation is open to closed wheel cars, SRF and SRF3 conforming to the GCR, or as amended in Fastrack, or those regional class cars per CENDIV Rules at Champ Series – Central Division and Vintage approved by Vintage Sports Car Racing Inc. (VSCR) cars conforming to GCR 3.1.4.C. Participation is closed to Formula Classes.

CAMERAS AND CAMERA MOUNTS: All cars participating in this event, except for Vintage classed cars, must have a forward-facing camera that is recording at all times while on track and that provides a clear, horizontal field of view of the cars and track ahead.

COURSE: Brainerd International Raceway, Competition Course (2.5 mile clockwise)

CAR SAFETY and TECH INSPECTION:

TECH: Driver School participants MUST PRESENT their helmet with a current year sticker (signifying that their driver gear and helmet has previously been inspected in the current year) are not required to present their gear at tech. Only the helmet and vehicle logbook are required to be presented at tech.

A driver whose helmet has not been issued a current year sticker must present all driver gear (as listed in the GCR), with the vehicle logbook. All other Tech requirements are described in GCR 9.3.

Cars must have passed SCCA Annual Technical inspection prior to the start of drivers school.

GENERAL:

EVENT SCHEDULE / RUN GROUPS: The event schedule or run groups may only be changed by the Chief Steward as needed to accommodate event circumstances. If changes are made prior to the start of the event, as much notice as possible will be given to all affected competitors. The schedule as published is for planning purposes only. Please listen to the PA system and pay attention to what is happening on track.

BLEND LINE: Cars entering the track from the pits must remain to the left of the blend line, until the end of that line at turn thirteen

PIT LANE: All competitors must maintain a slow, prudent speed on pit lane at all times. Use the transit lane until reaching and upon exiting your pit stall. Do not drive through other pit stalls. Tire scrubbing is not allowed at any time in the pit lane and in the transit lane. Tire scrubbing is permitted after the apex of corner 13.

CLOTHING: Closed-toe shoes, and shirts with sleeves are required in pit lane, false grid, and on the grid.

FUEL PROVIDER: Fuel is available with a credit card at the gas pumps outside the main gate.

CANCELLATION: If part of an event is cancelled for reasons of safety or forces beyond our control this event will be governed by GCR Appendix B, 1.2.A&B

DISABLED CARS: Disabled or damaged cars may be removed from the course and delivered to a central location. If the car sustained body/chassis damage, it will be released to the driver/crew after tech has made appropriate notations in the vehicle logbook. Cars disabled due to a mechanical failure will be released to the driver/crew immediately. If the car requires wrecker support to return to its paddock location, there may be a delay depending upon the availability of wreckers or flat tows.

BIR RACEWAY PADDOCK AND TRACK RULES:

1. **NOISE POLLUTION REGULATION:** No race car or engine, including street cars with open exhaust, shall be run before 8:30 a.m. or after 6:00 p.m.
2. **WRISTBAND REQUIREMENT:** A wristband indicating you have registered for the event must be presented to the person at the Main Gate to allow your entry onto the property of Brainerd International Raceway.
3. All minors must always be under direct parental or acting guardian supervision.
4. Drivers are responsible for the conduct of their crew and guests.
5. Drivers may be held responsible for harm to property, including damage to the track and to the environment. Fees charged for the removal / disposal of hazardous waste or used tires will be assessed to the responsible driver
6. All pet animals must be leashed or humanely confined and cleaned up after.
7. All trash must be placed in the receptacles provided
8. No vehicular traffic will be allowed on the track racing surface from 6pm – 8am without the permission of the Chief Steward.
9. Irresponsible use of any vehicle is prohibited. Riding on the outside of any vehicle or trailer is prohibited. These vehicles shall be operated by street licensed drivers. All race support vehicles must have race car number and class prominently displayed. These vehicles shall be operated by street licensed drivers.
10. The use of motorized or non-motorized scooters, skateboards, inline skates or any type of wheeled shoe is forbidden. No radio-controlled devices may be operated from 8:00am – 6:30pm.
11. Firearms, weapons, explosives and illegal drugs are strictly prohibited on the premises.
