FRIDAY TEST AND TUNE:

Race car test and tune event, rotating groups. Novice license holders authorized by the ICSCC License Director are welcome. Paddock entry restricted to participants, officials, and volunteers until 4pm.

TECHNICAL INSPECTION:

Entries with a 2024 Annual Tech sticker on your logbook can complete your race tech form at registration and receive your weekend tech sticker then and there and be good to go. Drivers without 2024 Annuals must have your car and apparel inspected by an authorized tech official. Tech officials will be roaming Friday evening or bring your car and gear to the scale station area for inspection.

## Poker Race Rules

1. All Closed Wheel cars eligible
  - a. Cars will be classed according to NWMECS classes
  - b. NWMECS rules apply except as noted below
2. Duration - 40 minutes
3. Pitstop(s) – 1 minimum, 2 maximum
  - a. Takes place between 5-minute mark and 35-minute mark
    - i. No pit-stops under yellow
    - ii. No Driver change
  - b. 30 – second duration
    - i. Every \$10 donation to the Workers Fund reduces this by 5 seconds
    - ii. Stoppage time written on windshield
    - iii. \$60 donation equals a stop and go
  - c. Speeding in the Pit-lane results in the loss of three cards.
4. Poker Hand
  - a. Each driver gets three cards at the Drivers meeting
  - b. Drivers get three more cards at each pit stop (that's why you may want to stop twice!)
    - i. Note your car number will be noted. You'll get your cards after the race.
  - c. First place finisher gets two additional cards.
  - d. Second place finisher gets one additional card.
  - e. Max of 9 cards in your hand.
  - f. Best Poker hand overall wins the Grand Prize.
