Event Registration will be at the Tech Center. Gates open at 5PM Friday for early load in.

Your colored wristband must be worn on your left arm and shown to the grid marshal upon request when you enter the track for your Group session.

You must have visible numbers on the sides of your car. We have numbers if you do not and must be requested during registration.

Group Sessions shown in red will be led by a pace car. This is to assure individuals have an opportunity to learn the track before running at speed. If your first day at the event is Sunday, you will be required to run with the Novice Group for your first session.

Advanced & V. Advanced level drivers can be certified to take passengers age 18 and above. All passengers need to check in, present a valid driver's license, sign the waiver, pay the \$50 rider fee and obtain a rider wrist band.
