TrackSprint Specifics

Event Description: This event will include TrackSprint track sessions all day Saturday. Groups will be determined based on car classification.

- Gates open at 7:00 AM on 7/6/2024.
- On-site Check-In is open Saturday from 7:00 to 8:30 AM.
- A draft version of the session schedule is available. A final schedule will be provided at check-in. We expect three on-track sessions per group during the day. The schedule is subject to change during the event, so please listen for PA announcements.

- If more than 120 cars are registered, we will offer a waitlist. If space becomes available, wait-listed drivers will be contacted at least 48 hours before the start of the event.
- **Refunds & Withdrawals:** Refunds are available prior to on-track participation. Once a car has turned a wheel on track, no refunds will be given.

Timing and Scoring: Timing and scoring procedures for the TrackSprint are as follows:

- Transponders are required for this event. If you don't have a Tranx260 compatible transponder, you may rent one through www.motorsportreg.com for \$35 for the event.
- Sprint sessions will be based on three different track configurations with one practice and three timed runs for each configuration. The driver's best time for each configuration will count toward a cumulative score for the day.
 - Any driver not completing a timed configuration will be credited with a 2:00 (two-minute) time for that configuration.
- All cars must display a car number on both sides of the car. Numbers should be 8 inches high in a color that contrasts with the car's paint. Masking tape numbers are acceptable if they are readable.

Time Attack Specifics

Event Description: This event will include Time Attack track sessions all day Sunday. Groups will include Novice, Intermediate, and Advanced.

- Gates open at 7:00 AM on 7/7/2024.
- On-site Check-In is open Sunday from 7:00 to 8:30 AM.
- A draft version of the session schedule is available. A final schedule will be at check-in. We expect four on-track sessions per group during the day. The event officials reserve the right to change before or during the event, so please listen for PA announcements.

Timing and Scoring: Timing and scoring procedures for the Time Attack are as follows:

- Transponders are required for this event. If you don't have a Tranx260 compatible transponder, you may rent one through www.motorsportreg.com for \$35 for the event.
- Scoring will be determined by each driver's best-timed lap from each timed Time Attack session.
 - Any driver not completing a timed lap during a timed session will be credited with a 2:00 (two-minute) lap for that session.
- All cars must display a car number on both sides of the car. Numbers should be 8 inches high in a color that contrasts with the car's paint. Masking tape numbers are acceptable if they are readable.
- Grid position for Practice Session 1 is first come first served. Each session thereafter, grid positions will be determined based on the participant's fastest time of the event. Grid positions will likely change each session as lap times are improved.

Time Trial Specifics (combined)

Event Description: This version of the event will include Time Attack and TrackSprint track sessions by tabulating times from both Saturday and Sunday. Groups will include Novice, Intermediate, and Advanced.

Registration: Registration requirements are as follows

- **Entry Fees:** \$325.00, Non-members must purchase an SCCA Weekend membership for \$25.00.
- Drivers may register for this event online at www.motorsportreg.com. Online Registration closes at 12:00 PM on 7/5/2024. A \$25.00 Late Registration Fee applies to entries submitted after 12:00 PM on 7/5/2024.

Timing and Scoring: Timing and scoring procedures include the requirements for the TrackSprint and Time Trial events. Scoring will be determined by each driver's best-timed lap from each timed Time Attack session plus their cumulative TrackSprint time.

Elements Common to both days (all Events)

Car Classes: The following car classes will be available for this event:

- All car classes listed in the National Time Trial Car Class Rules (the "Rules") are allowed.
- All cars must meet the SCCA Time Trials Vehicle Eligibility requirements to participate in this event.
- Vehicles, including open-wheel vehicles that are listed as "not eligible" per the SCCA Time Trials Vehicle Eligibility requirements will NOT be allowed.
 - *For avoidance of doubt, no open wheel cars will be allowed at this event.*
- If you need clarification about your vehicle's eligibility, review the SCCA Time Trials Vehicle Eligibility requirements or contact the Event Lead or Ambassador.
- Car classification protests must be filed by 5:00 PM on Saturday, 7/6/2024

Awards: Awards will be presented after the completion of the events for each day.

2024 OPTT Challenge Presented by HAWK: This event will be the fourth points event of the 2024 OPTT Challenge Series.

Neohio Region Time Trials Supplemental Regulations

Grid & Pit Lane Rules:

- All cars entering the track during “hot” sessions must have an appropriate Tech Sticker.
- Only participants with the appropriate wristband will be allowed in pit lane and on track.
- The Grid Steward positioned at the entrance to the Pit area controls traffic through the gate. Drivers must follow the instructions of the Grid Steward before proceeding into the Pit area.
- Be aware at all times of foot traffic in the Pit and Paddock areas.
- No uncredentialed minors are allowed on Grid or in the Pit Lane during activities.

Paddock Rules: The rules of the paddock area are as follows:

- Paddock speed limit is “walking speed” and it is strictly enforced. Speeding in the pit/paddock/access roads, and reckless driving (even on track) are strictly prohibited and could result in removal from the property.
- Only licensed drivers may operate any motorized vehicles in the paddock.
- Please place wood or other material between any jacks and the asphalt.
- If you have a fluid spill, please get in touch with an event official immediately. Oil dry is available.
- The organizers and the track management are not responsible for damage or theft of equipment or belongings.

Track Rules: Once track sessions have started, all access to the paddock will be via the bridge over the front straight. A vehicle must wait to cross at the crossover gate between live sessions if it exceeds the bridge weight limit.

Services on or near the track: 93 Octane Fuel will be available for sale at the track. Parts stores and other services are available in the nearby towns of Garrettsville and Warren.

Camping & Accommodations:

- Camping is available for participants (including volunteers) at the track. Arrangements should be made with track management by contacting the Track Manager (fredwolfe917@gmail.com).
- Area hotels can be found via the map function on MotorsportsReg.com.

Pets: Nelson Ledges is a pet-friendly track. So pet-friendly that your pet may get a biscuit when it shows up. That being said, pets must always be on a leash or a lead.
