



Purpose, Driving Event Rules and Requirements

The purpose of the MPH Guardrail Club Membership and Open Track days is to provide our members, their guests, and other qualified drivers with a fun, organized and well-run series of monthly driving events. Our goal is to provide an outstanding value for your driving investment.

All our Guardrail Club members, their guest and all participants are expected to be safe, courteous, and respectful of their fellow drivers and attendees, both on the track and in the paddock. Everyone drives by the same rules. Guardrail Club members are our "track family", sharing our passion for driving our cars on the track and taking pride in being part of fun, safe and respected performance driving community.

Who Can Drive at Guardrail Club Member + Open Track Days?

- Current Guardrail Club members
- Their guests (as outlined in their membership level)
- Experienced and Qualified non-Guardrail Club members
 - Non-members will be asked to provide verifiable previous road course experience during event registration. Failure to provide this information will result in your event registration being denied and refunded.
- Qualified Sponsors and other VIP Guests of MPH
- Open and closed-wheel cars are welcome. (Will run in separate run groups)
- NOTE: ALL drivers must be 18 years of age. *(unless they hold a valid competition license from a race sanctioning body)*

Pre-Event Registration is Required

- Sorry, no "arrive and drive" registrations allowed. *(we can help you with online registration – just ask!)*

Required Driving Attire

- Long pants, long-sleeve shirt, and closed-toe shoes. Driving suits/jackets, gloves, head & neck restraint devices and racing shoes are encouraged.
- If you are driving a purpose-built race car, full driver protection gear is expected.
- Helmets: **SA2015 or SA2020 ratings only.** No M- or DOT-rated helmets will be allowed. Period.

General Event Schedule:

- **Fridays:** Gate Open: 1 PM, Driver's Meeting: 1:30 PM, On-Track: 2-5 PM
- **Saturdays:** Cars & Coffee at the Track: 7:30 – 9:30 AM, Driver's Meeting: 9:30 AM, On-Track: 10 AM – 4 PM (12:30 PM lunch break)

General Rules of the Track: Guardrail Club & Open Track Days

- All cars are expected to be in top mechanical condition for driving at speed on our road course. It is the driver's responsibility to bring a safe, properly maintained, and prepared car to the track. Please refer to the MPH Tech Inspection form as a guideline for pre-event vehicle prep.
- All drivers are expected to know and respect the rules of the event. Failure to do so may result in your driving privileges being suspended for the day.
- Both driver and passenger side windows are to be DOWN when on track.
- Convertibles: tops must be in the "up and secured" position, fabric top must be free of tears/holes. A roll bar is highly recommended.
- MPH Passing Zones and Pit Exit / Blend Line rules will be strictly enforced. Passing allowed in three passing zones. Point-byes required and all passing to be done on the left. (See track map – will be detailed at driver's meeting)
- Drivers are expected to know the meaning of all control and communications flags used by MPH staff and to respect their commands and/or information.
- On-track spins or four-wheels off the driving surface constitutes an "automatic" black flag for that driver. Please report to pit road / black flag station.
- Multiple spins or four-wheels off may result in your driving privileges being suspended for the day.
- Multiple Black Flags during the day may also result in your driving privileges being suspended for the day.
- Absolutely no aggressive or intimidating behavior will be tolerated: either on track or in the paddock / pit area. Respect your fellow drivers, their crews, and families.
- This is an Open Track Day – NO DRIFTING. No donuts or "smoke shows" either.
- Events are run rain or shine. On-track sessions will be suspended if severe weather and/or lightning is in the area.
- NO Passengers allowed in Advanced or Intermediate run groups unless they are 1) In-car Instructors provided by the track or 2) approved by track manager / race control.
- Numbers on your vehicle are highly encouraged. Numbers should be of contrasting color to the vehicle and placed not to obstruct driver vision. Numbers may also be added to the upper passenger corner of the windshield and upper corner (driver's side) of the rear window.
- No minors operating motorized vehicles in paddock / pit / Race Port areas.
- Personal behavior: Participants are asked to practice prudent social distancing if / when Covid-19 precautions are in affect.
- Pets are to ALWAYS be on a leash. PLEASE clean up after your pet...and yourself.
- Having fun IS required!

On-Track Sessions

- 20- to 30-minute alternating sessions (depending on total car count)
- Daily run schedule will be announced at Driver's Meeting

RV Spots / Race Port Reservations

- All RV spots and race port reservations will be handled on a first come / first served basis. Rental fees will be collected at the track once you are parked. For pricing and to make a reservation, email: manager@racemph.com

MPH Club House / The Well at MPH

- It is recommended that Saturday lunches be purchased during registration to insure availability.
- The Well at MPH may have a limited walk-up lunch supply if you do not pre-order your lunches during registration.
- PLEASE, no alcohol consumption by drivers until AFTER your driving day concludes. Any driver seen consuming alcohol during the driving day will have their driving privileges revoked for the day.

Facilities Damage / Exclusion from the Event

- You are responsible for any damage you may cause to our facility, including the cost of material and labor to repair and / or replace guardrail sections.
- You may be billed for material used to clean up oil or coolant if it is determined by race control that you did not 1) pull off the track or 2) obey flags to report to pit road and/or 3) continued to drive a smoking / leaking / puking car around the track.
- Failure to adhere to the above guidelines may result in your membership and driving privileges being suspended.
- The track reserves the right to ask any participant, crew, guest, or family member to leave the facility if their behavior is deemed inappropriate for the event.

CHECK YOUR HELMET'S SNELL RATING!

2022 HELMET REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL CAR EVENTS

***Snell SA2015 or SA2020 rated helmets are now
mandated by our insurance. Look inside your
helmet for the orange Snell rating decal - these
are the ONLY two ratings approved
for use at car events.***



DOT- or M-rate helmets are NOT approved for use on-track

MPH Guardrail Club Lapping Days

- * Gate 1: Enter Pit Road
- * Gate 2: Exit Pit Road
- ** **PASSING ZONES STRICTLY ENFORCED** **
- * Stop / Go Sign at end of Pit Road
- * Respect the Blend Line
- * Checkered Flag: Turn 1
