Vehicle Exterior / Body

- ☐ 1. Brake lights are fucntional and visible
- ☐ 2. Windshield and windows are clear and free of damage and / or cracks
- ☐ 3. Has rear and drivers side mirrors free of damage and / or cracks
- ☐ 4. Gas cap tightens and seals
- ☐ 5. All body panels, spoilers, lips, valences, splitters, etc. are well secured
- ☐ 6. Tire clearance is sufficeint and there is no rubbing
- ☐ 7. Corrosion is minimal and will not impact structural integrity of th evehicle
- ☐ 8. Driver and Passenger window are fully operational and will raise and lower

Seats, Seat Belts and Harnesses

- ☐ 1. Driver and passenger seats are the same design and quality
- ☐ 2. Driver and passenger belts or harnesses are the same
- ☐ 3. Seats and belts are securely anchored metal to metal
- ☐ 4. Seat belts are free of cuts, frays, and are unstretched
- ☐ 5. Race seats and harness are installed per manufacturer specifications
- ☐ 6. If vehicle is equipped with a five or six point harness (4 point harness with ASM only) these belts must be SFI / FIA rated and within the expiratin period. SFI, 2 years from date of manufacture, FIA 5 Years from date of manufacture.

Engine Compartment

- ☐ 1. Engine is free of excessive or unusual oil leaks
- ☐ 2. Coolant hoses are free of leaks
- ☐ 3. Fuel rail and lines are free of leaks
- ☐ 4. All accessory belts are properly tensioned and within manufactures specifications

Brakes

- ___ 1. Rotors are in good condition, unwarped / gouged and meet specification
- ___ 2. Calipers are properly attached and show no signs of leakage. All seals are intact
- ___ 3. Pads have more than 70% of their material remaining
- ___ 4. Brake fluid is DOT3 or better
- ___ 5. Brake fluid has been changed for this event and passes a dip test

Suspension

- ___ 1. No looseness in steering or suspension
- ___ 2. No bent, excessively corroded or cracked components
- ___ 3. Sway bars are mounted with appropriate links and hardware
- ___ 4. Shock absorbers free of leaks and firm
- ___ 5. Axle bolts are tight, boots are free of leaks and no excessive play

Tires and Wheels

- ___ 1. Tires have at least forty-percent of their original tread and are worn evenly
- ___ 2. Tire rating is H or better.
- ___ 3. Tires are free cuts, cracks, bubbles, plugs, and other repairs or defects
- ___ 4. Tires are no more than five years old
- ___ 5. All tires are the same make and model, mixing and matching is not allowed
- ___ 6. Wheels are free of cracks and bends

Exhaust System

- ___ 1. All connections are secure and suspension points secured
- ___ 2. Pipes and mufflers are intact, attached, and free of any holes
- ___ 3. Heat shields are well secured
- ___ 4. Corrosion is not excessive
- ___ 5. Exhaust dB is less than ninety decibels at fifty feet
