We are very excited for you to be joining us for the upcoming three-day school.

We'll meet at 8:30am in the MSR Lounge on Day 1 in order to complete all the necessary paperwork.

We'll paddock under the awnings. Feel free to unload your racecar under the awnings, but please don't park trailers under the awnings. Garages will be available to store your racecar overnight, so you don't need to worry about bring canopies or pop-ups.

Fuel is available on-site. Keep an eye on your fuel gauge. If you need fuel at the end of a session, go straight to the pumps when you come off track in order to save time. NOTE: Rental Miata and B-Spec race cars take 93 octane.

Lunch is provided each day, but you may want to bring additional snacks. We'll have coolers of water.

The weather in south Texas can change rapidly and the wind blows fiercely at MSR. Having a light jacket, shorts, pants, t-shirt and/or sweatshirt on hand is never a bad idea.
